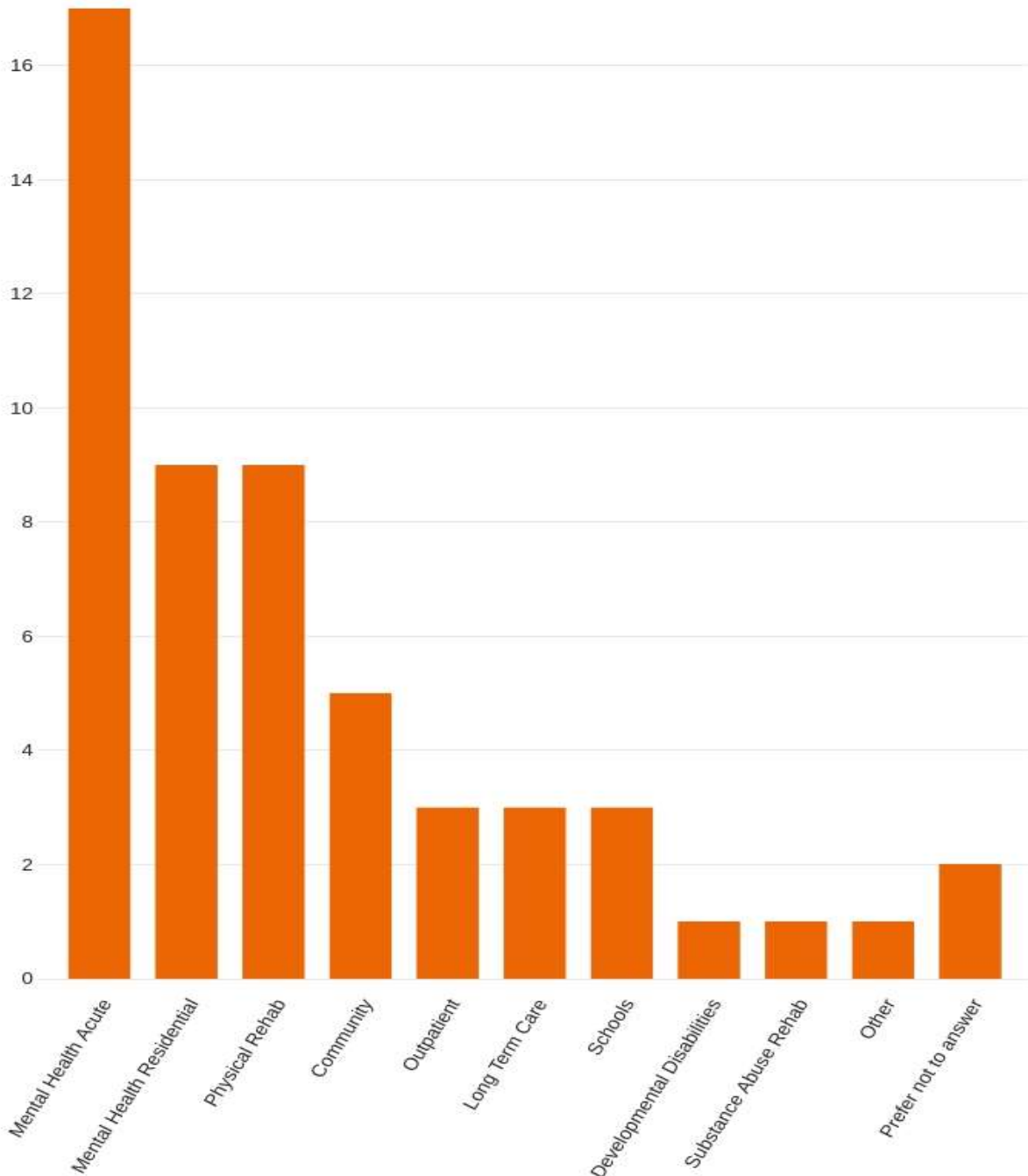

Overall Report

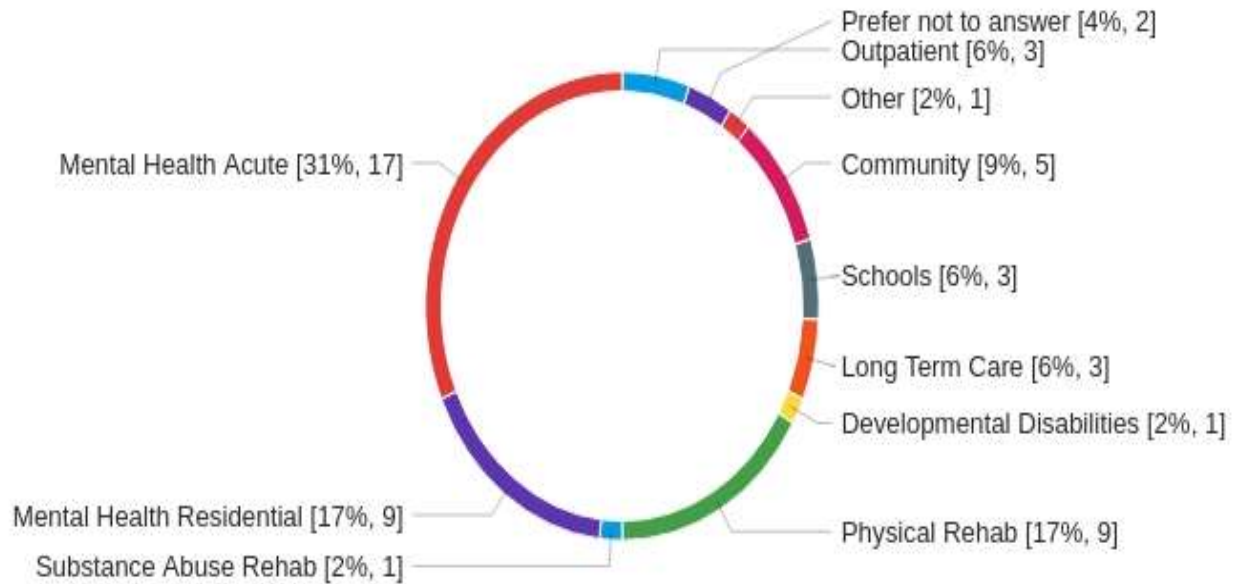

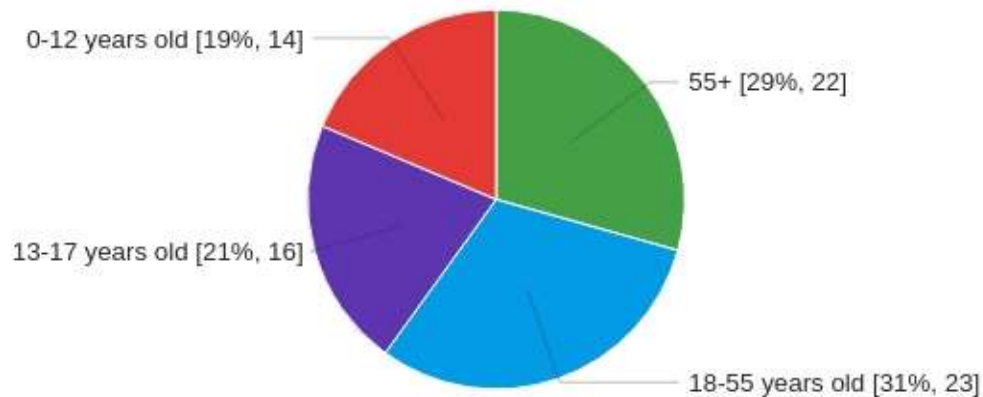

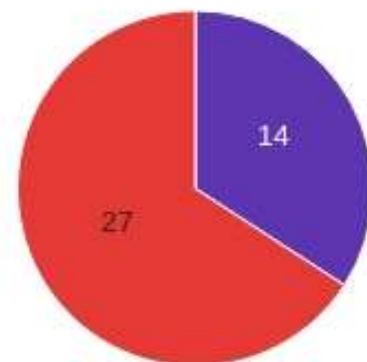

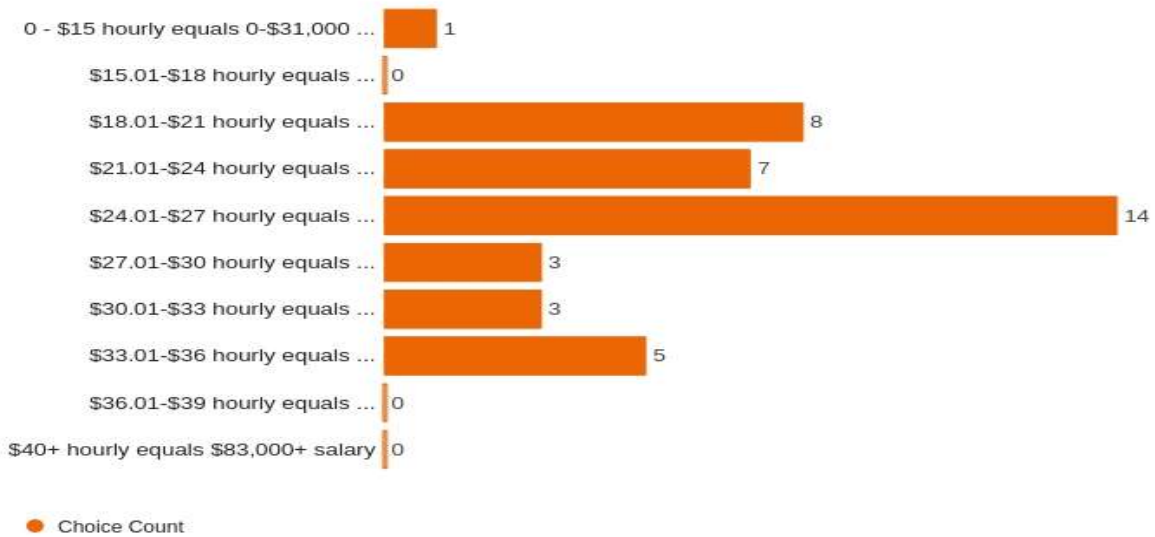

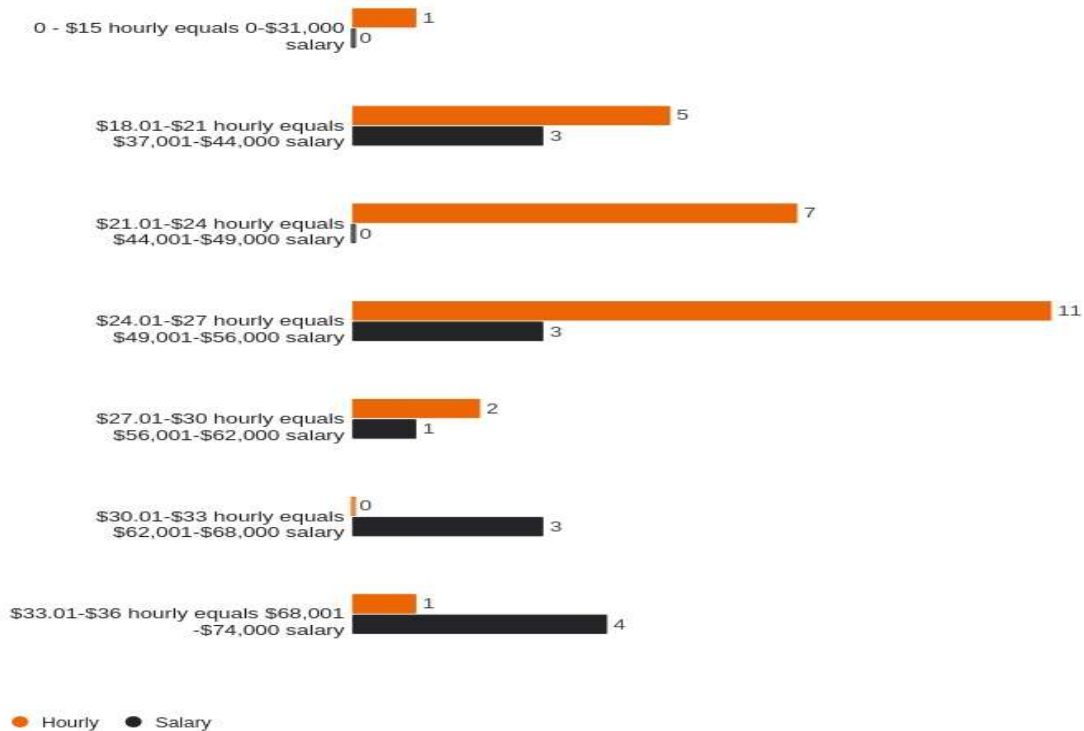

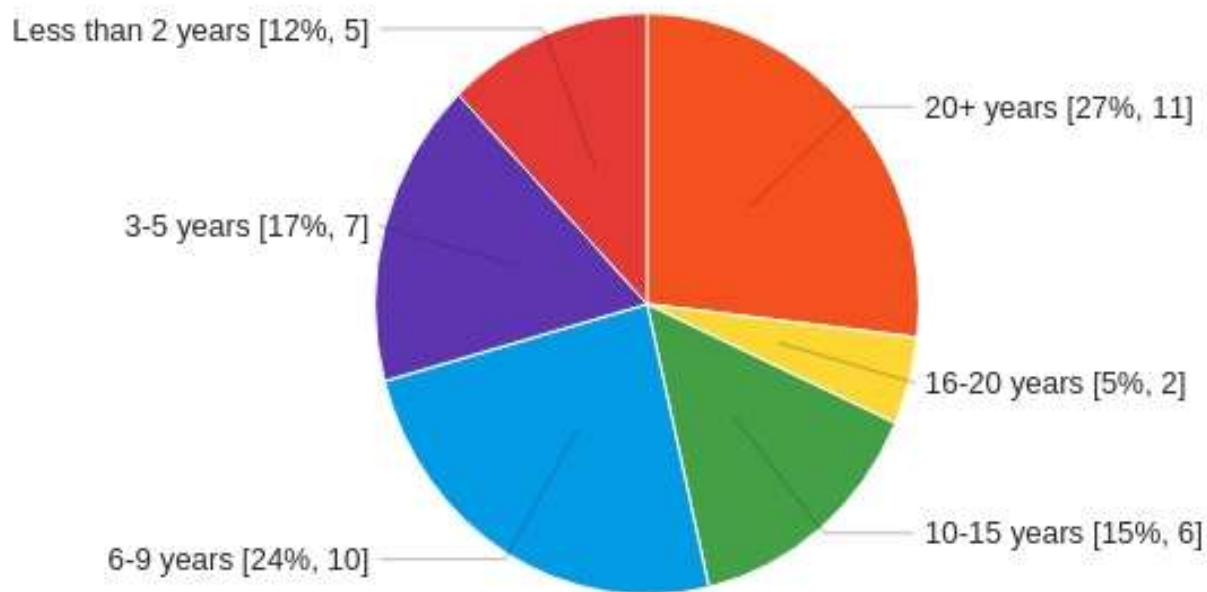
Hourly & Salary Differences in Pay

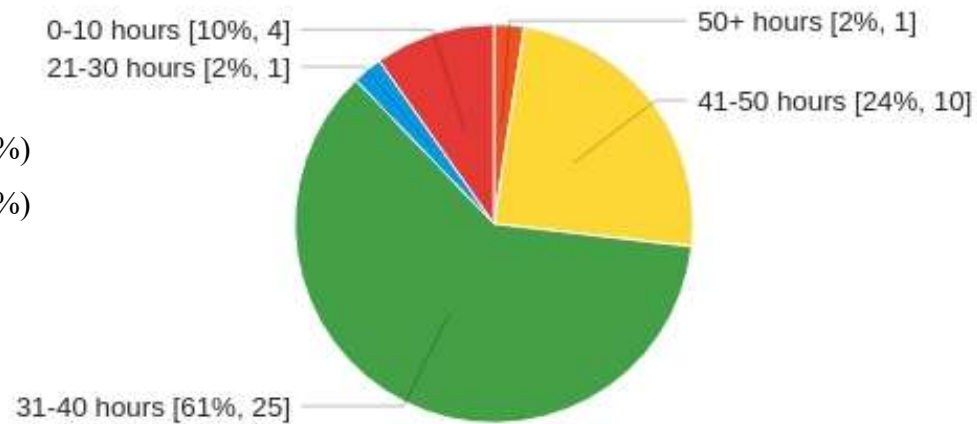

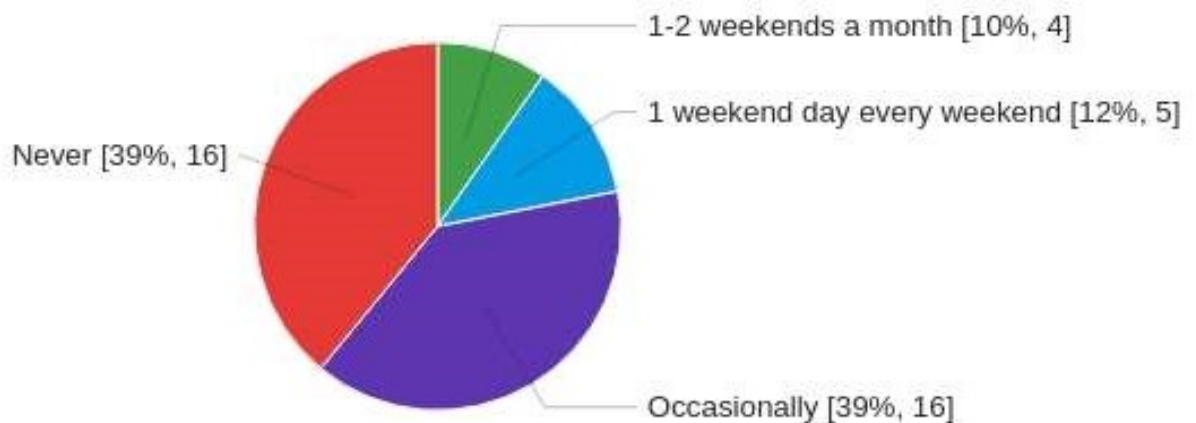

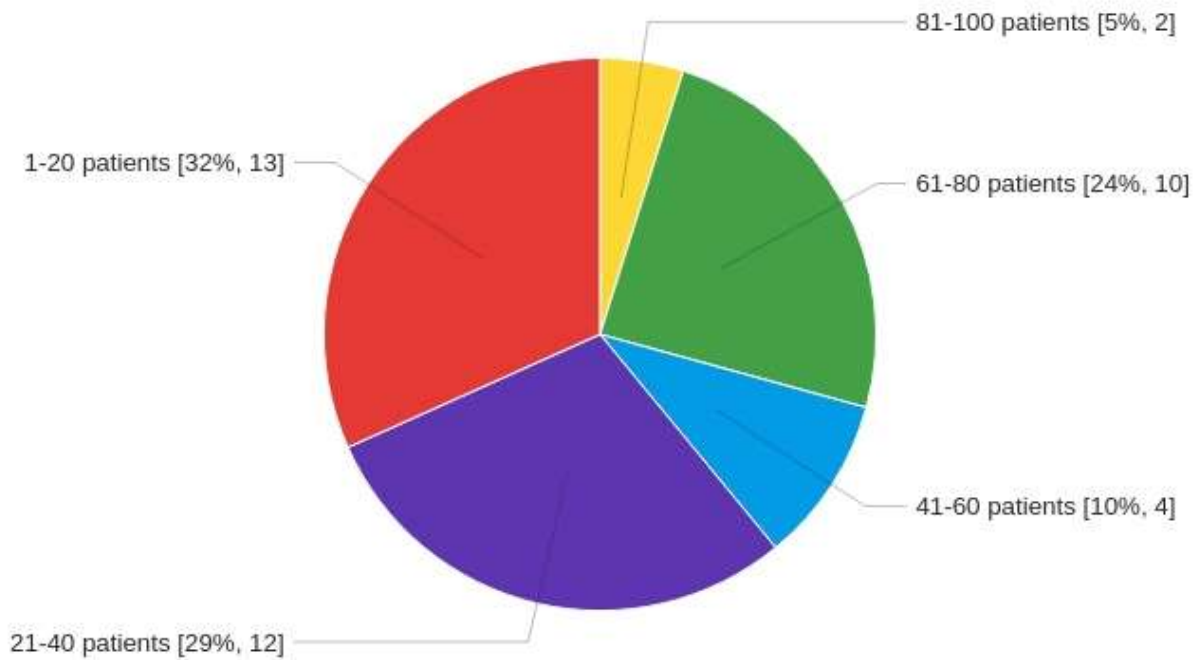

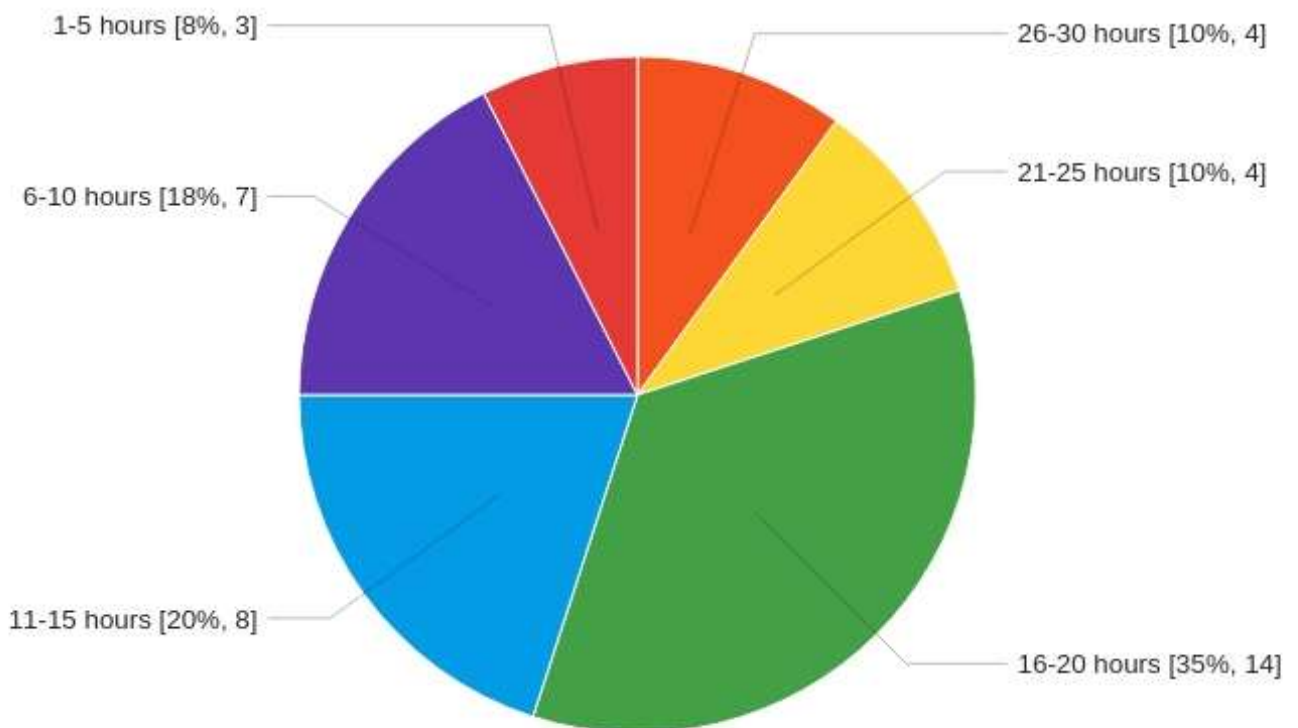

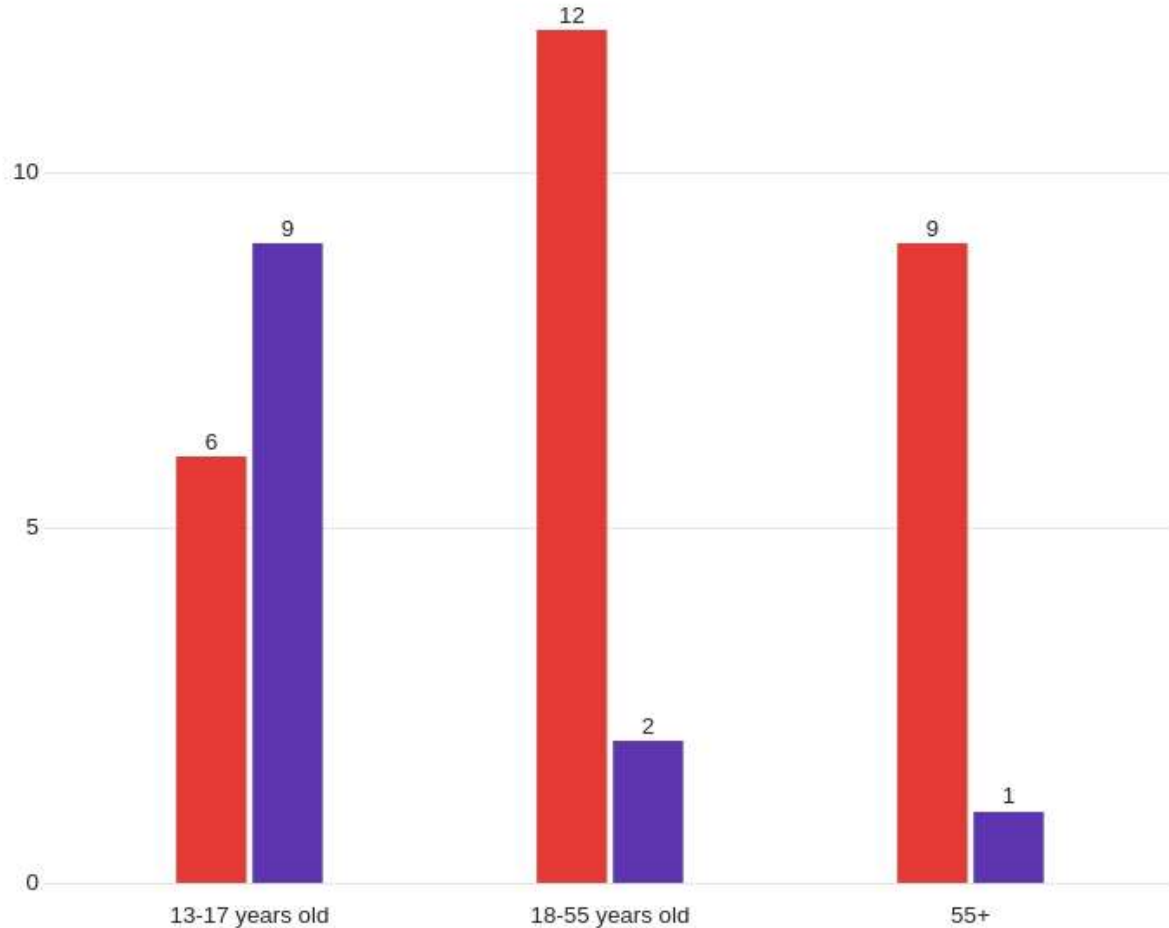

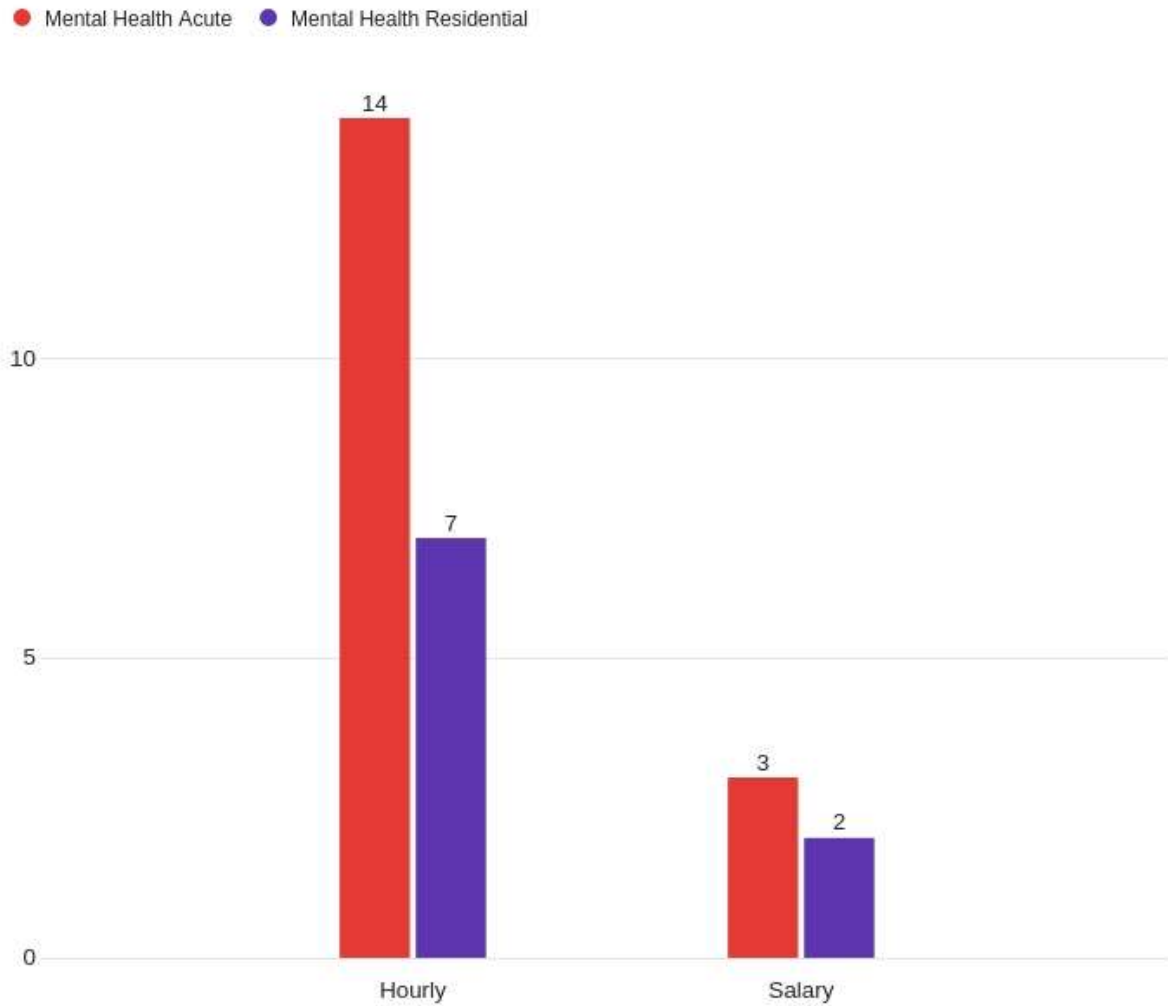

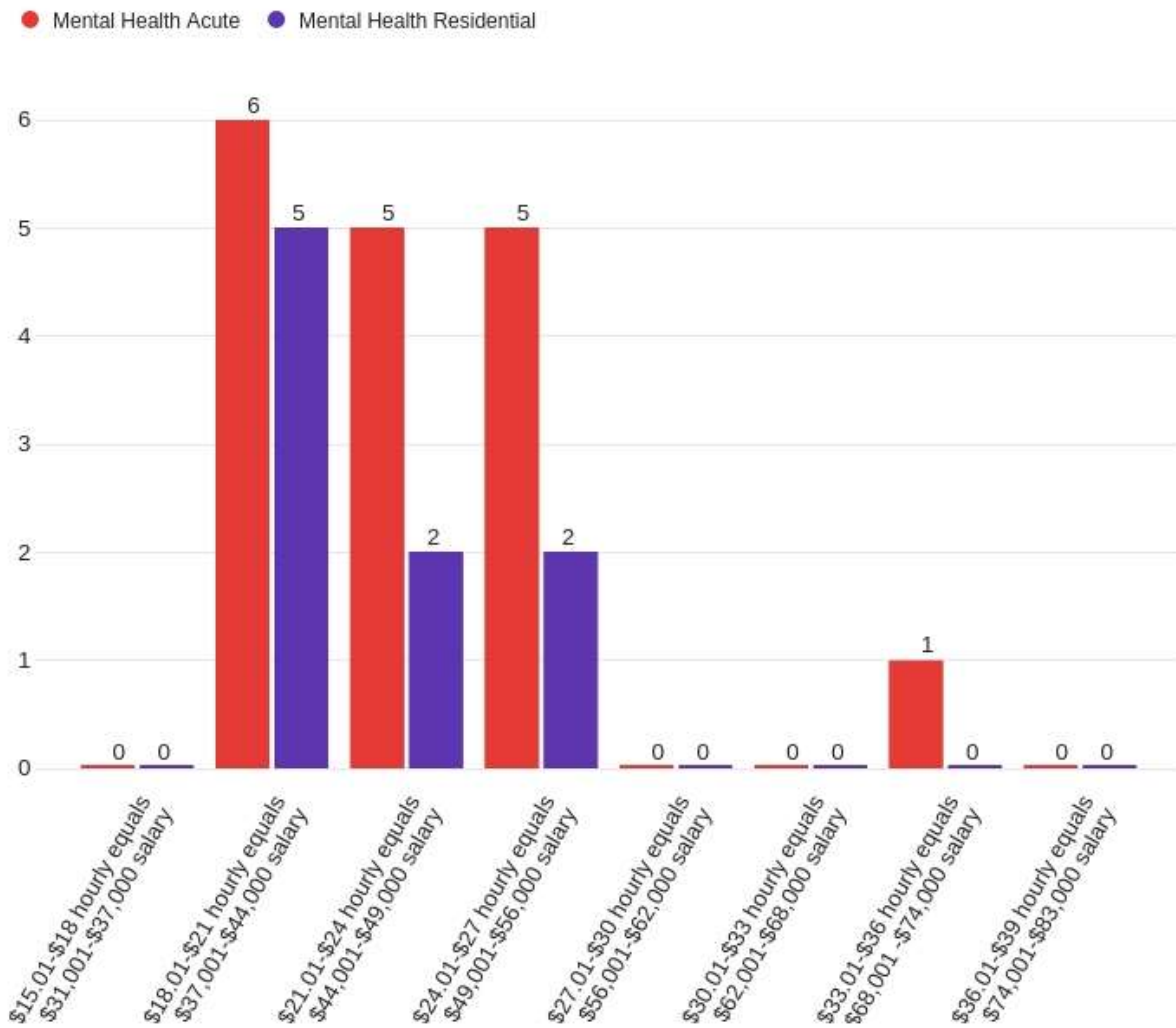

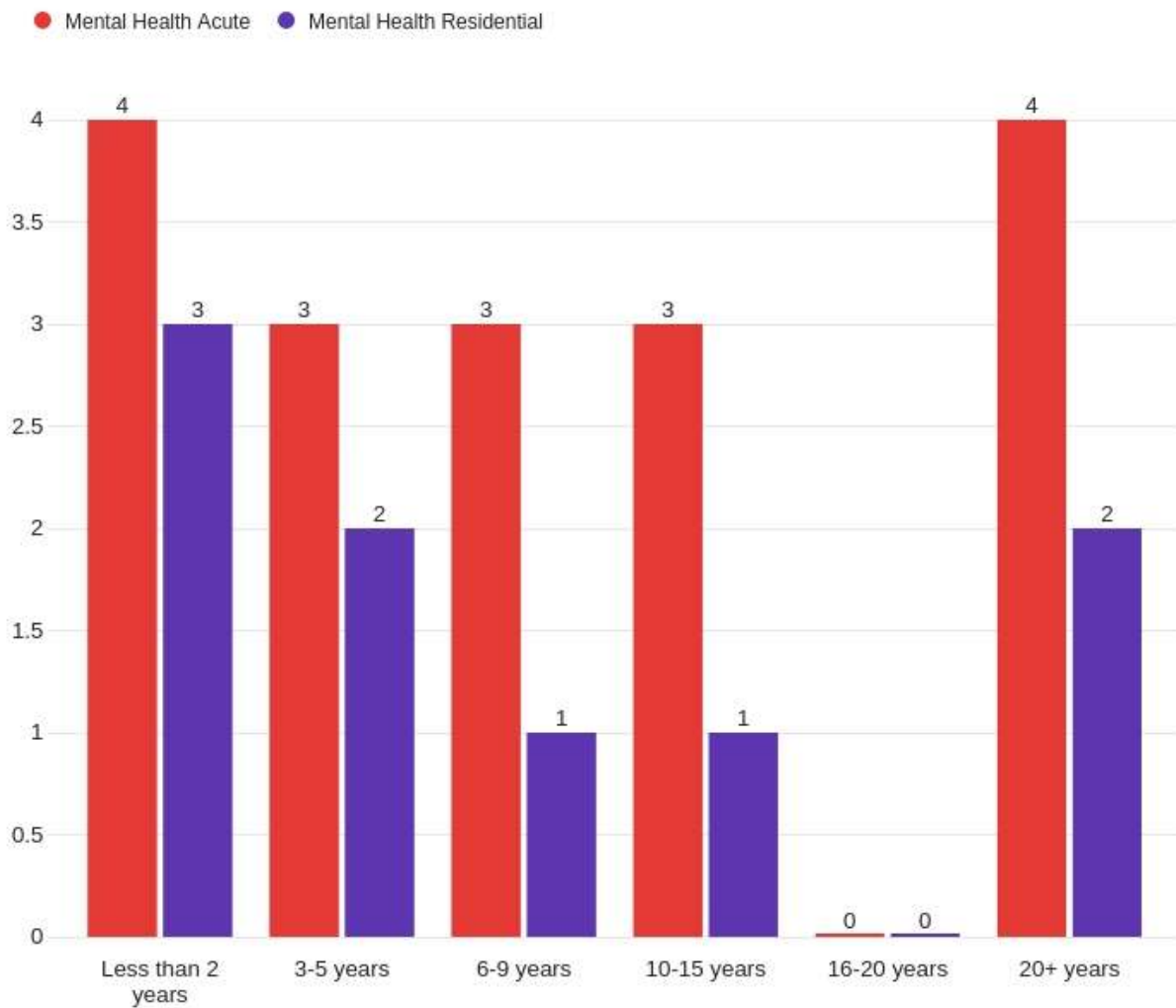

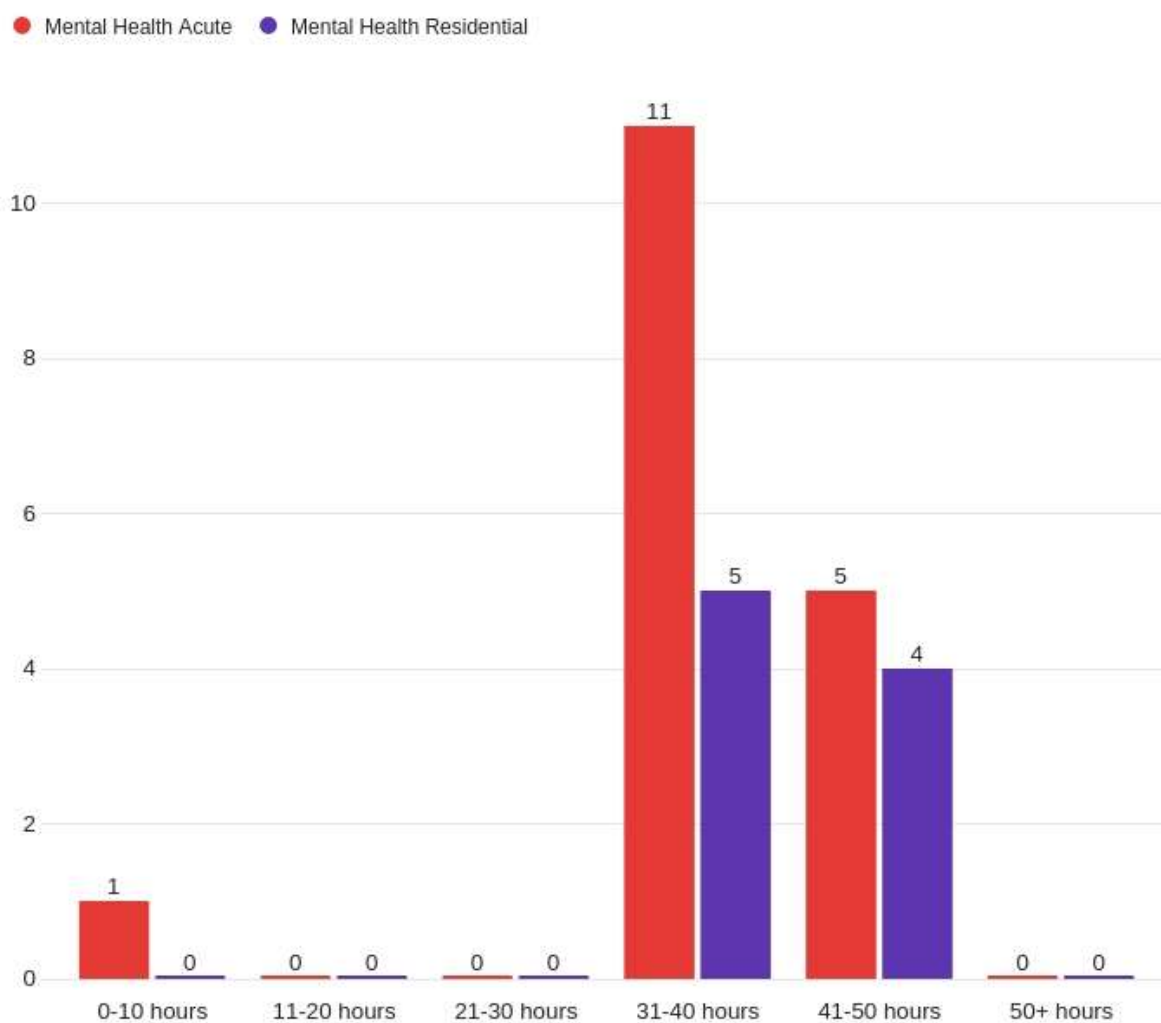

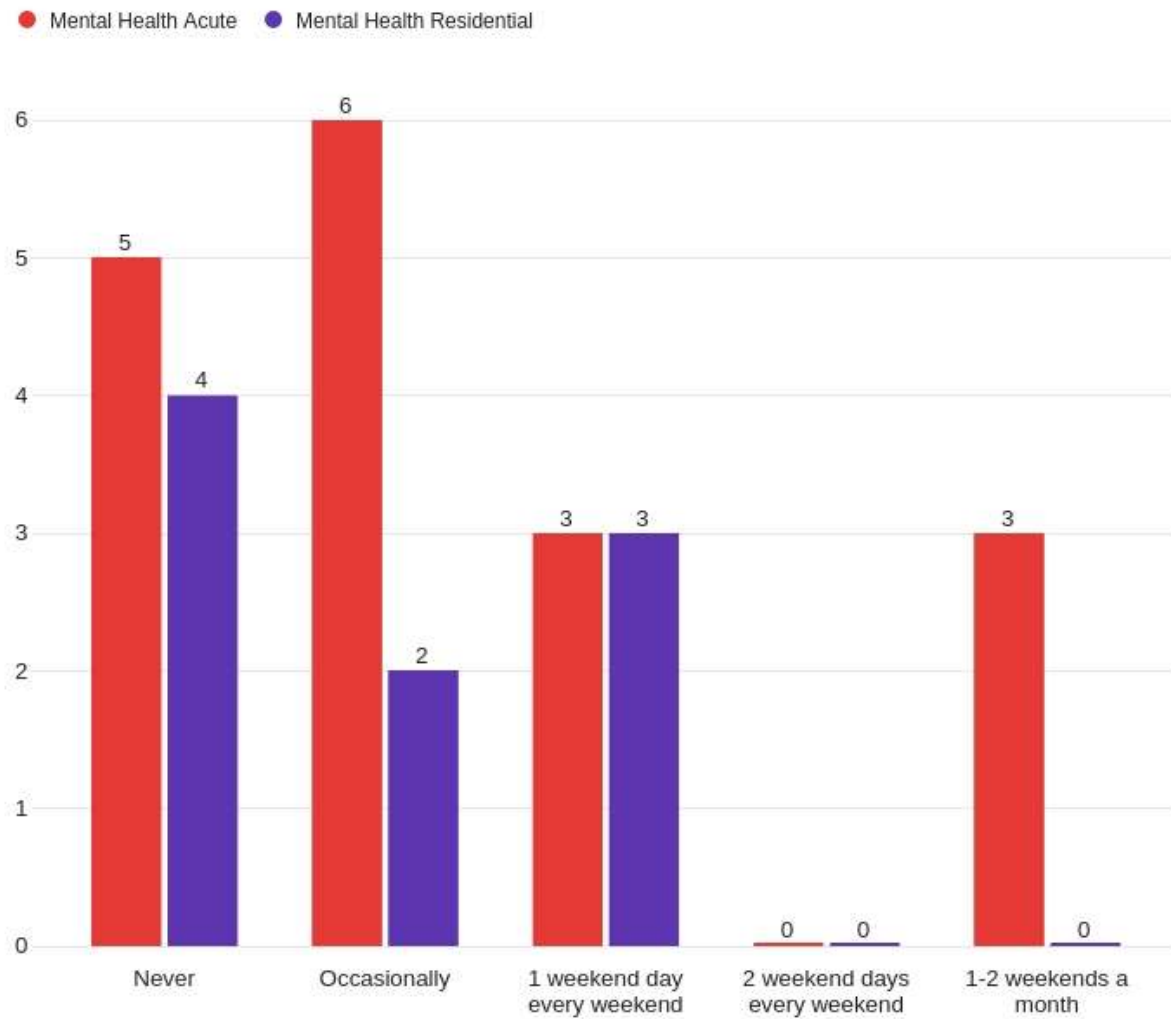

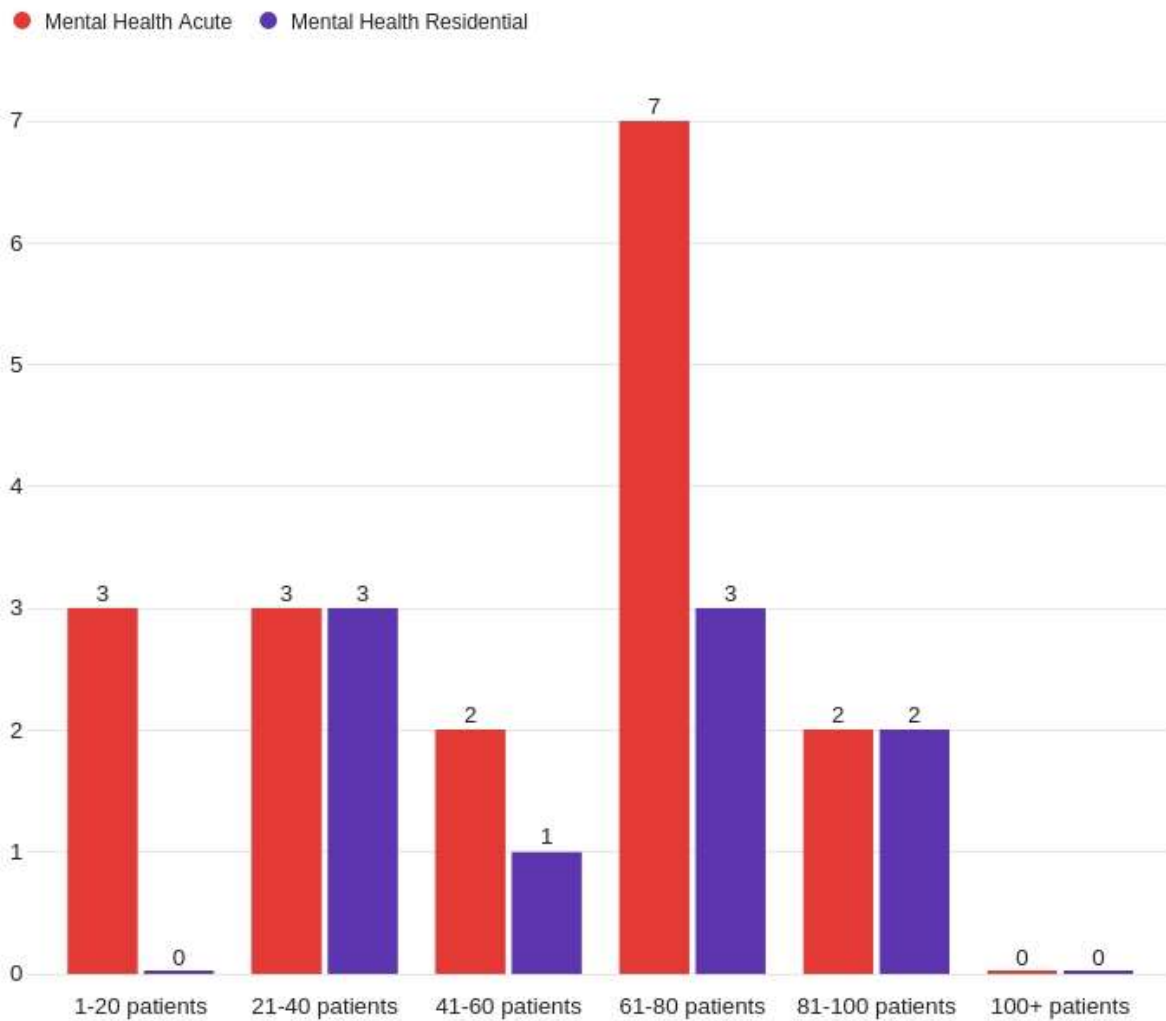

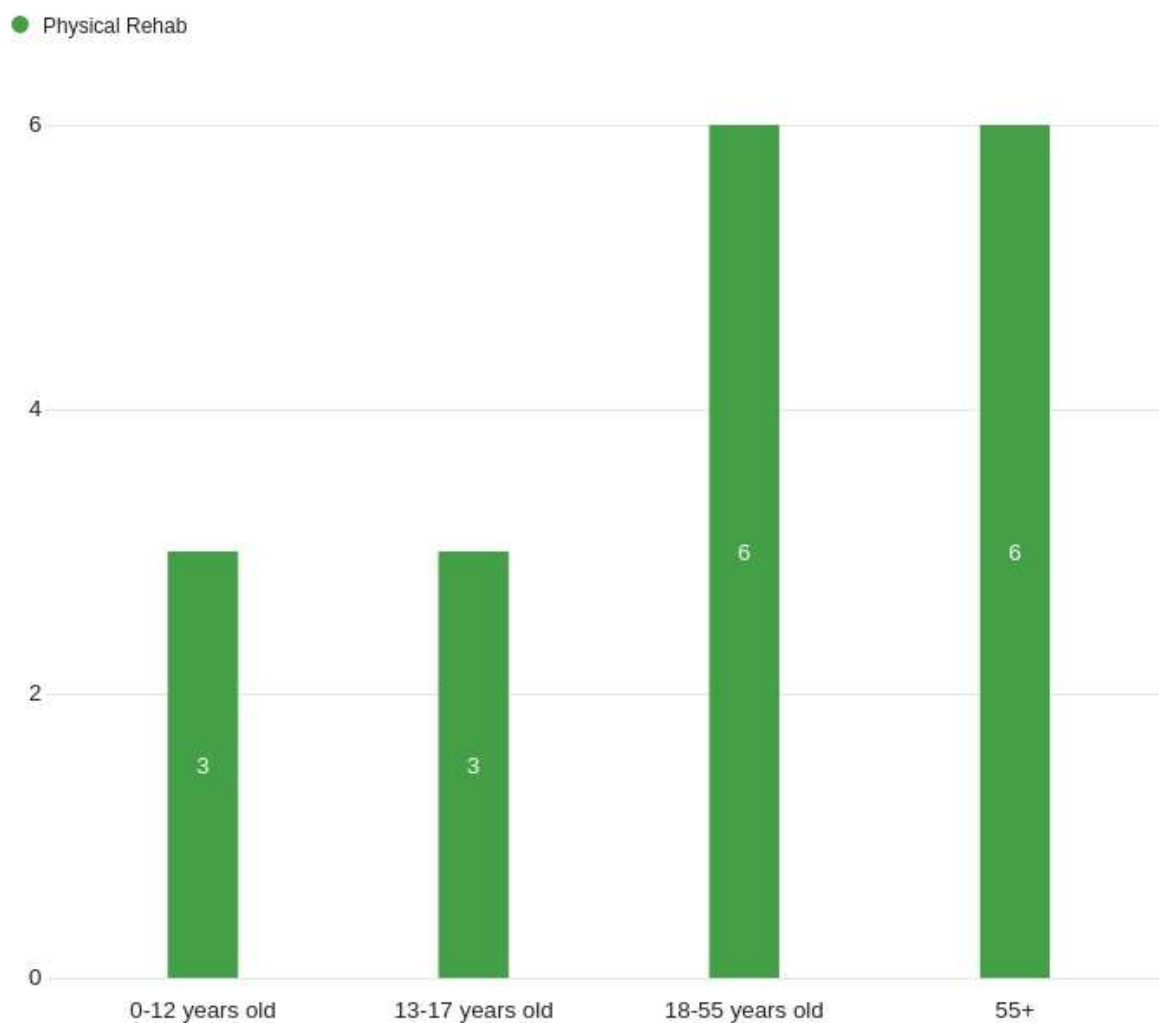

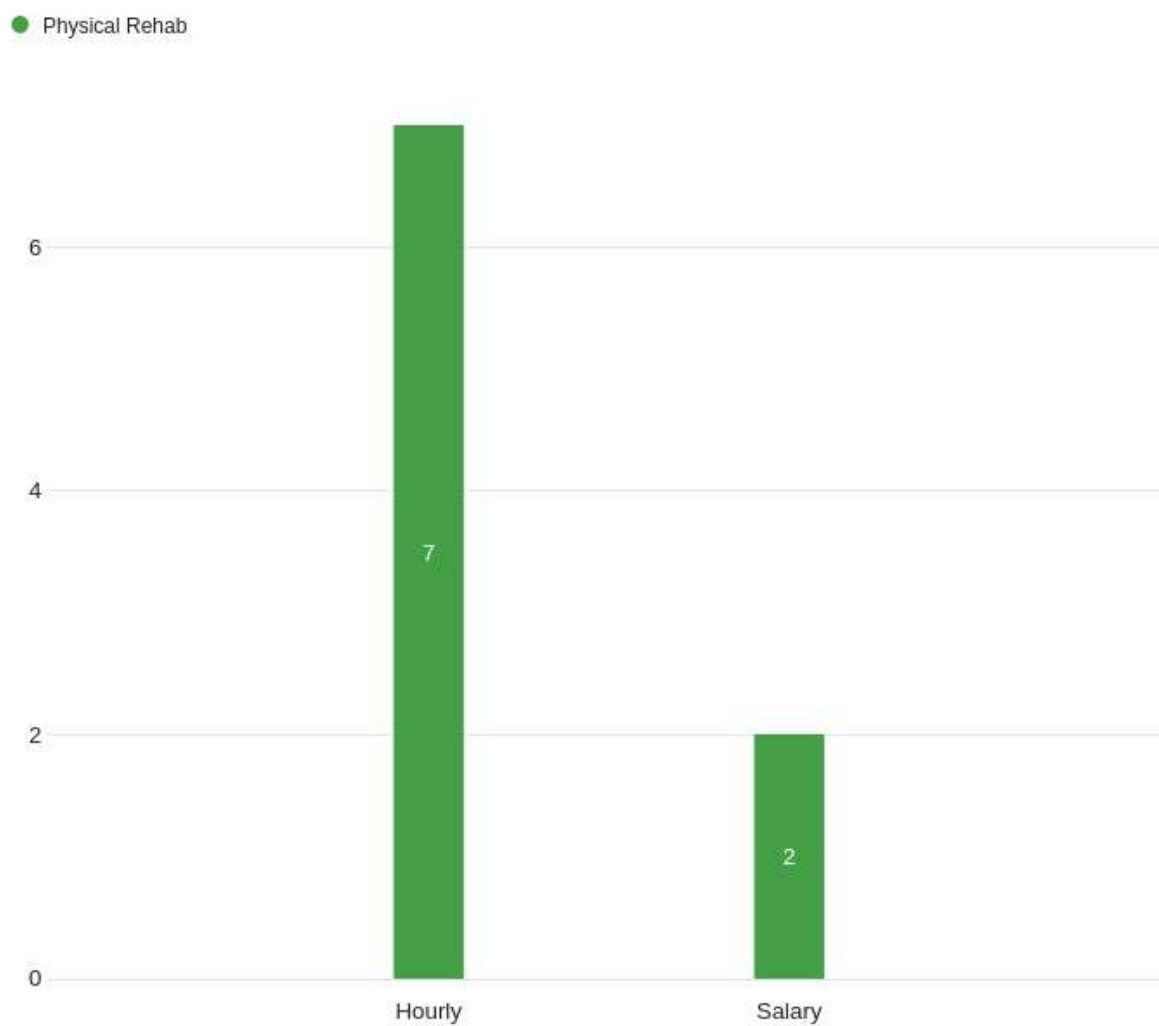

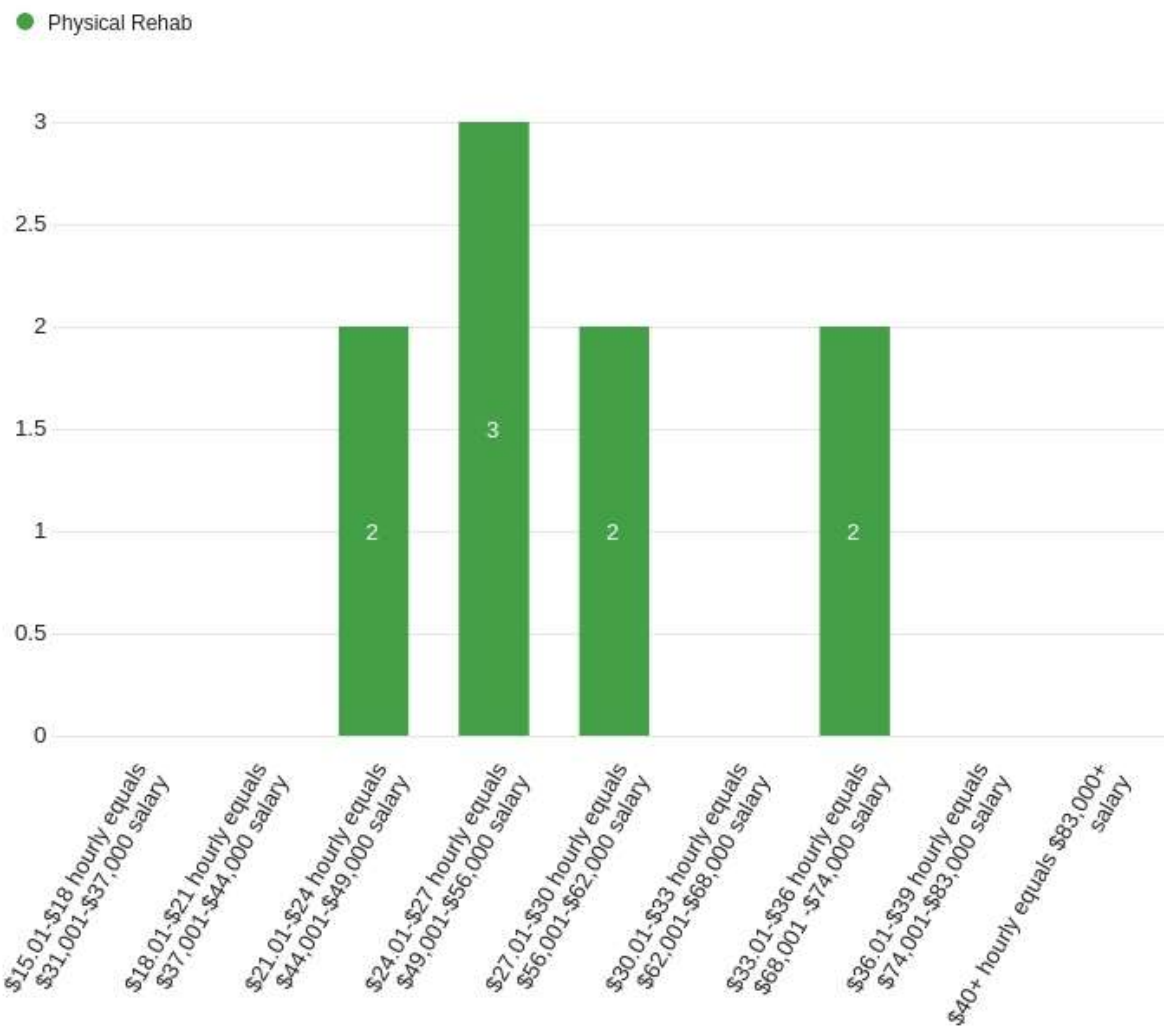

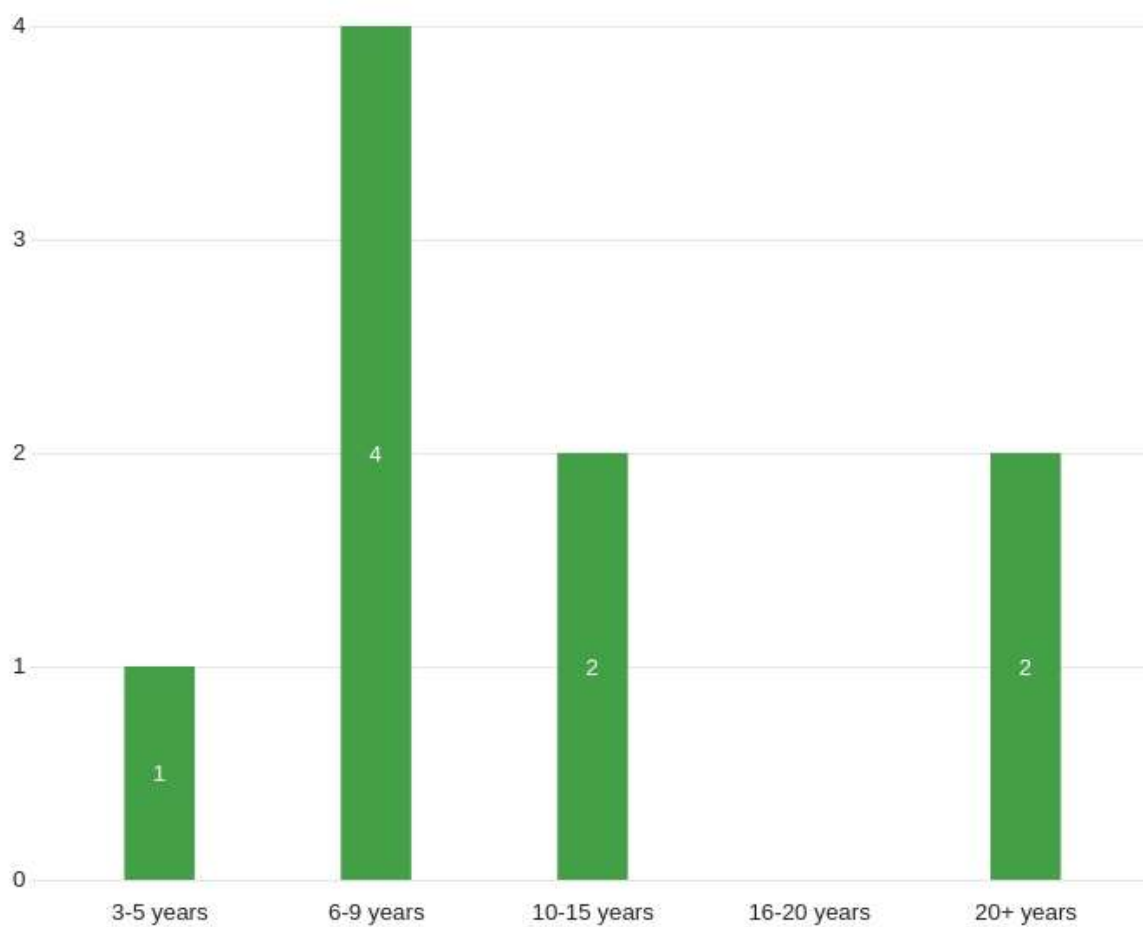

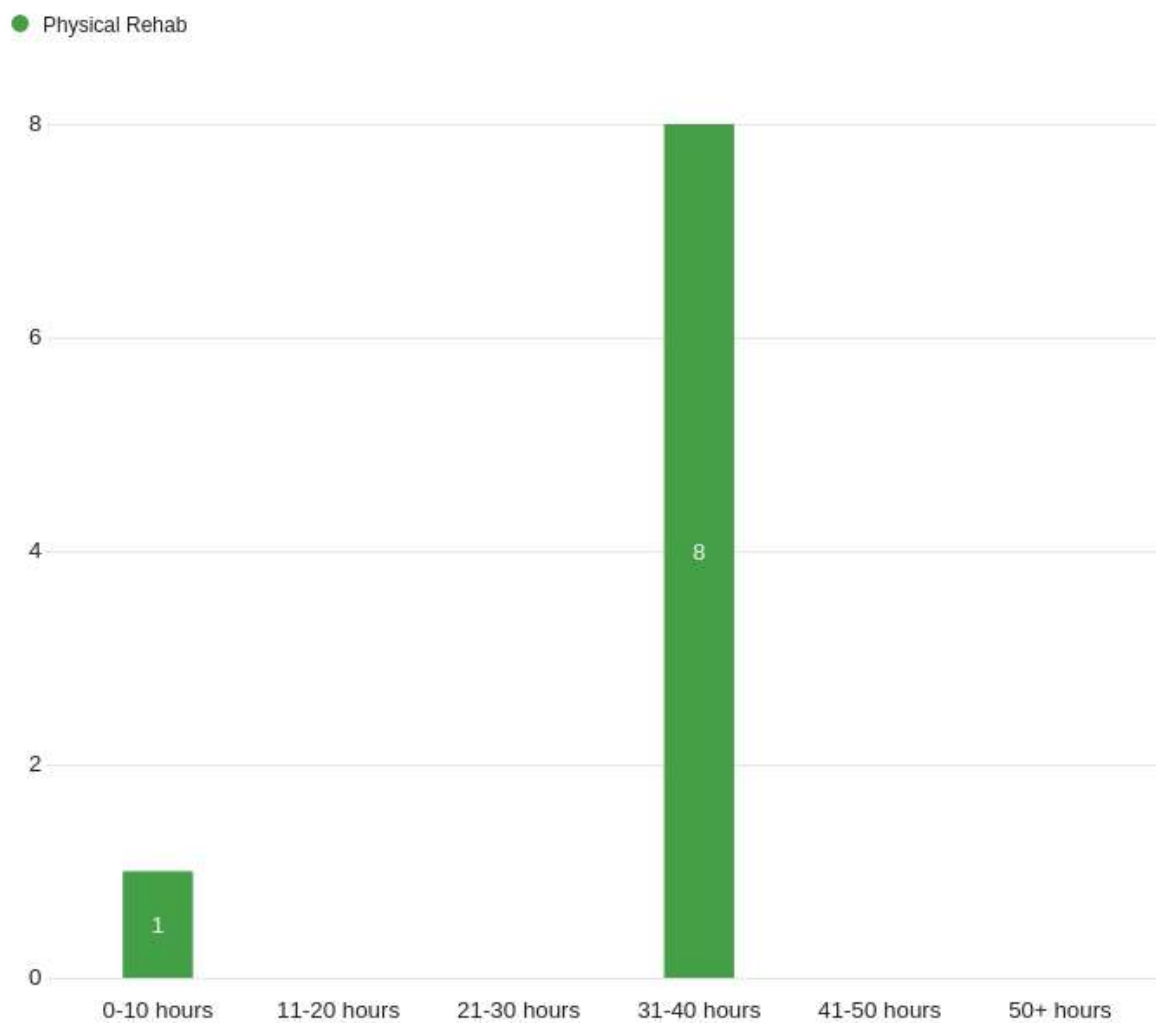

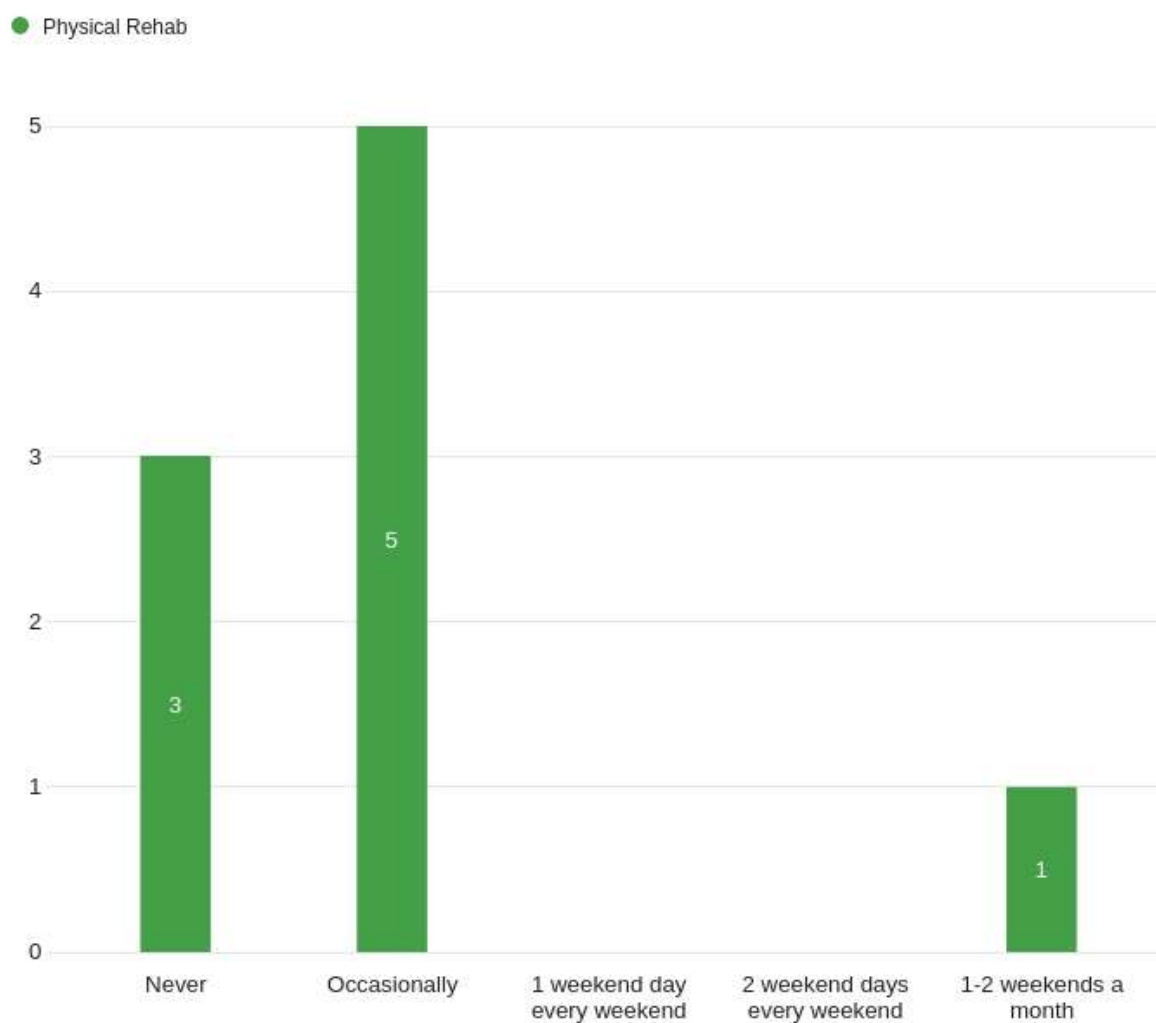

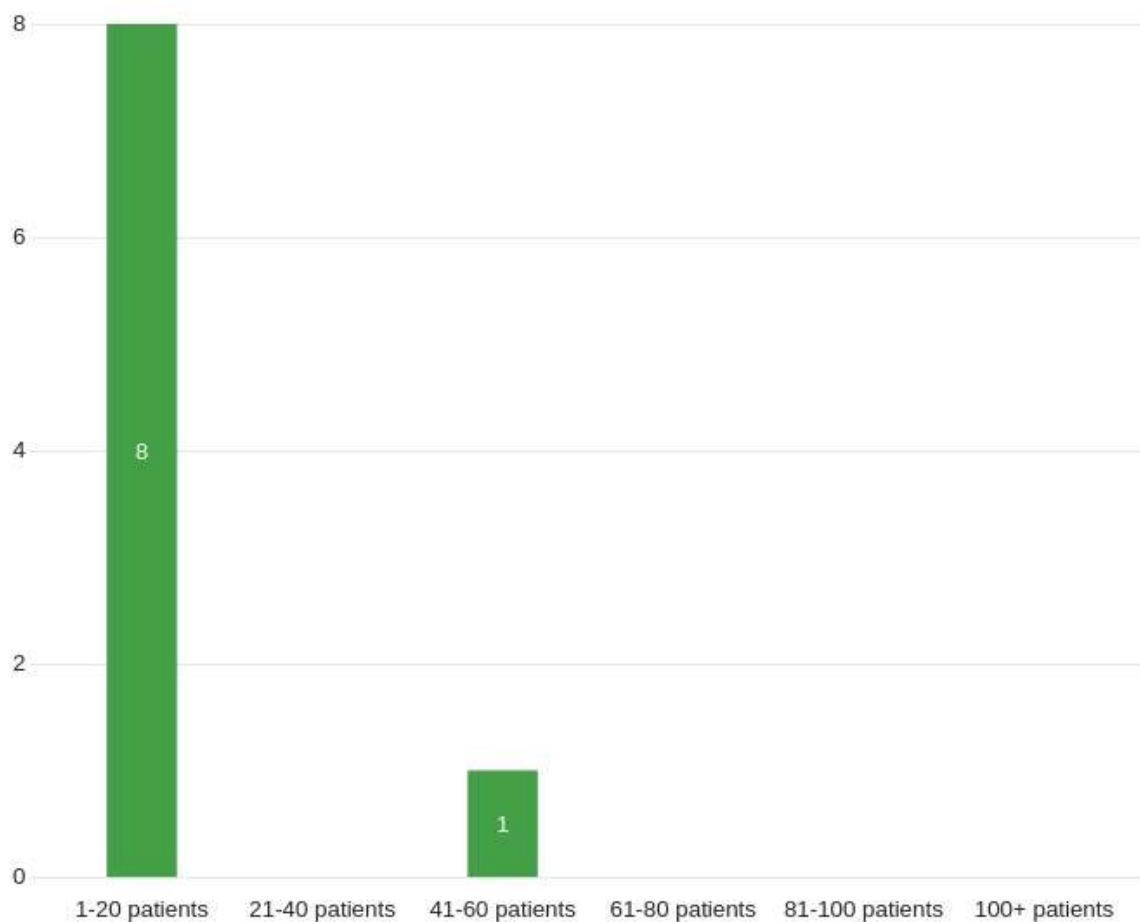

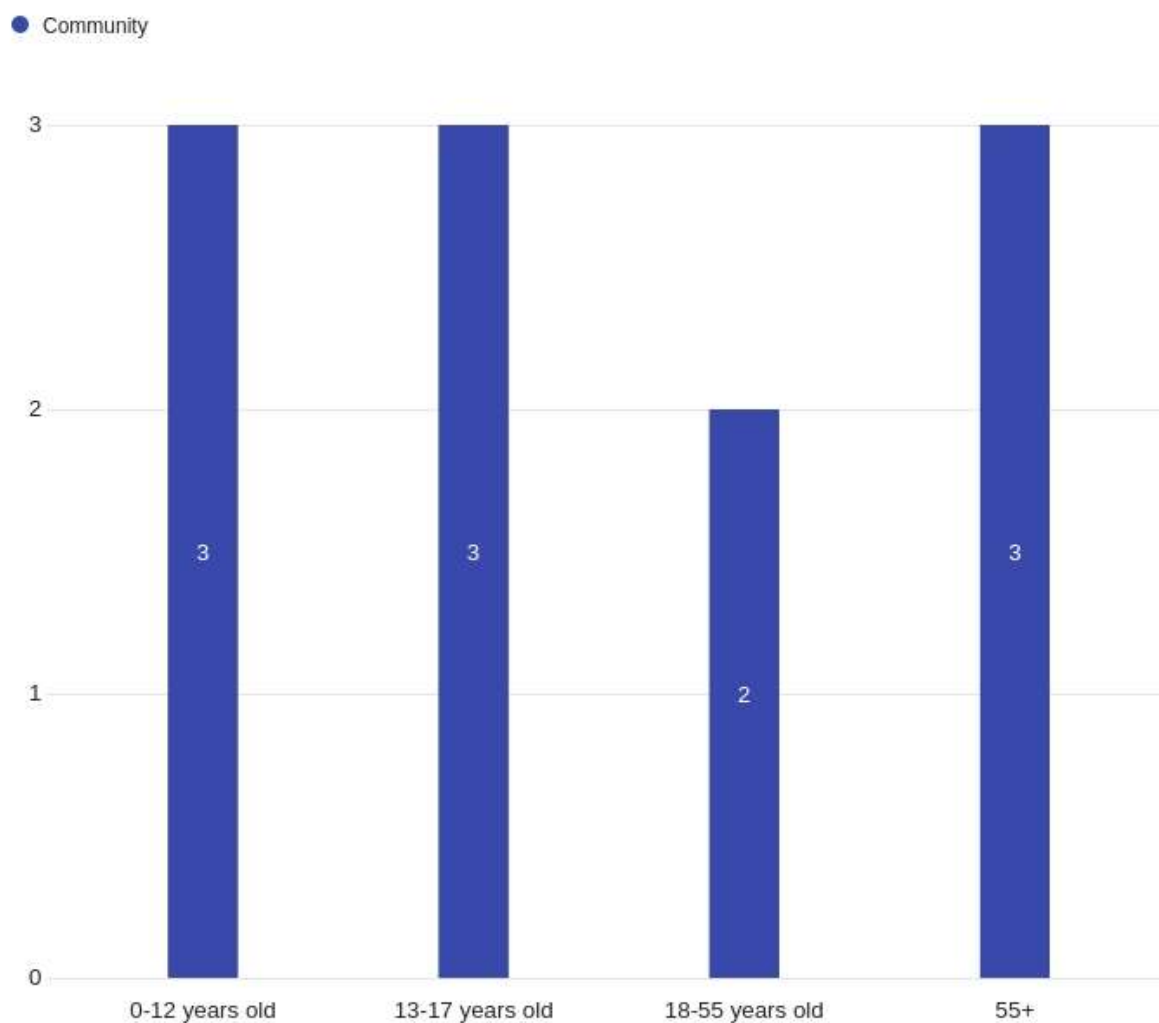

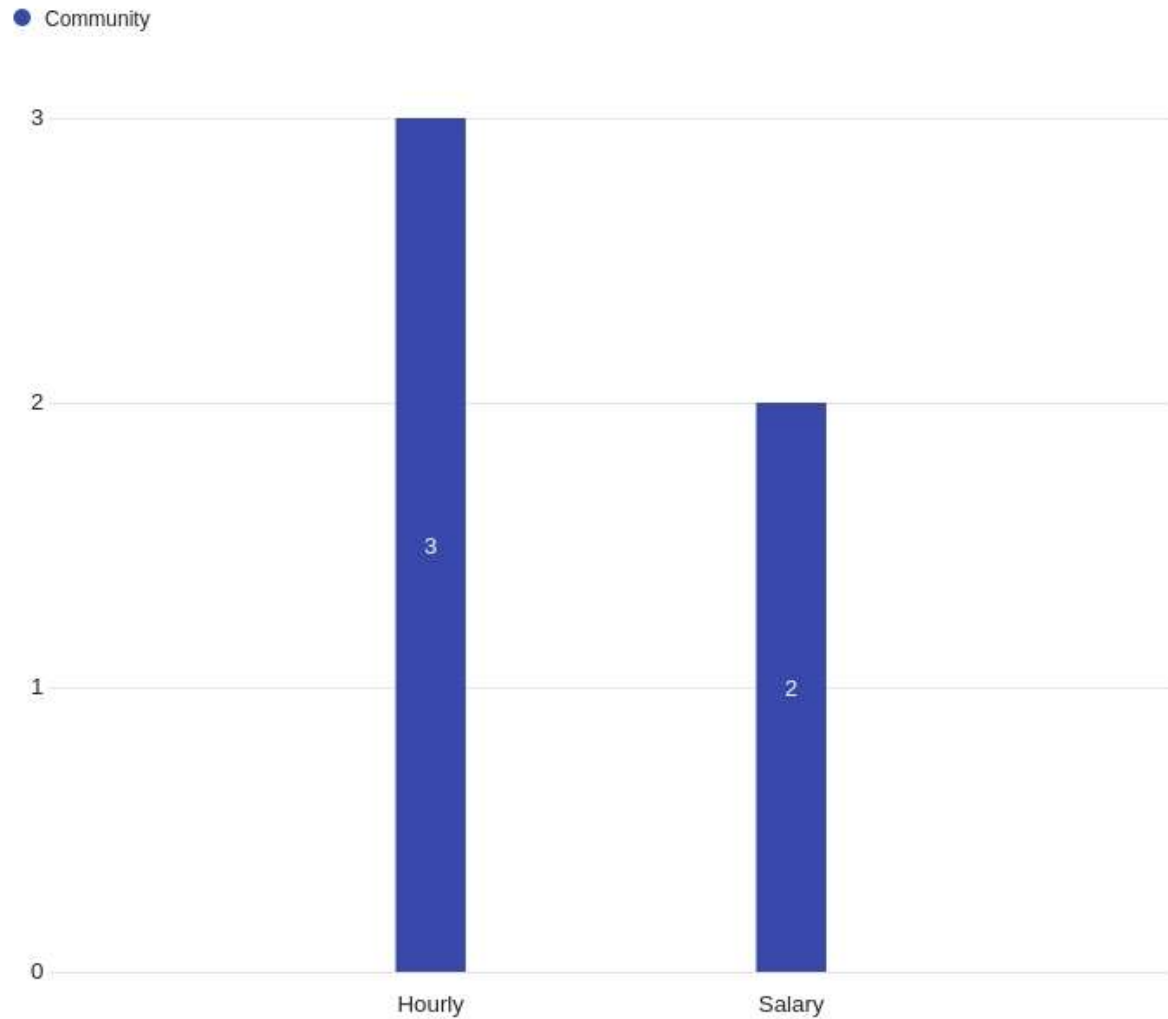

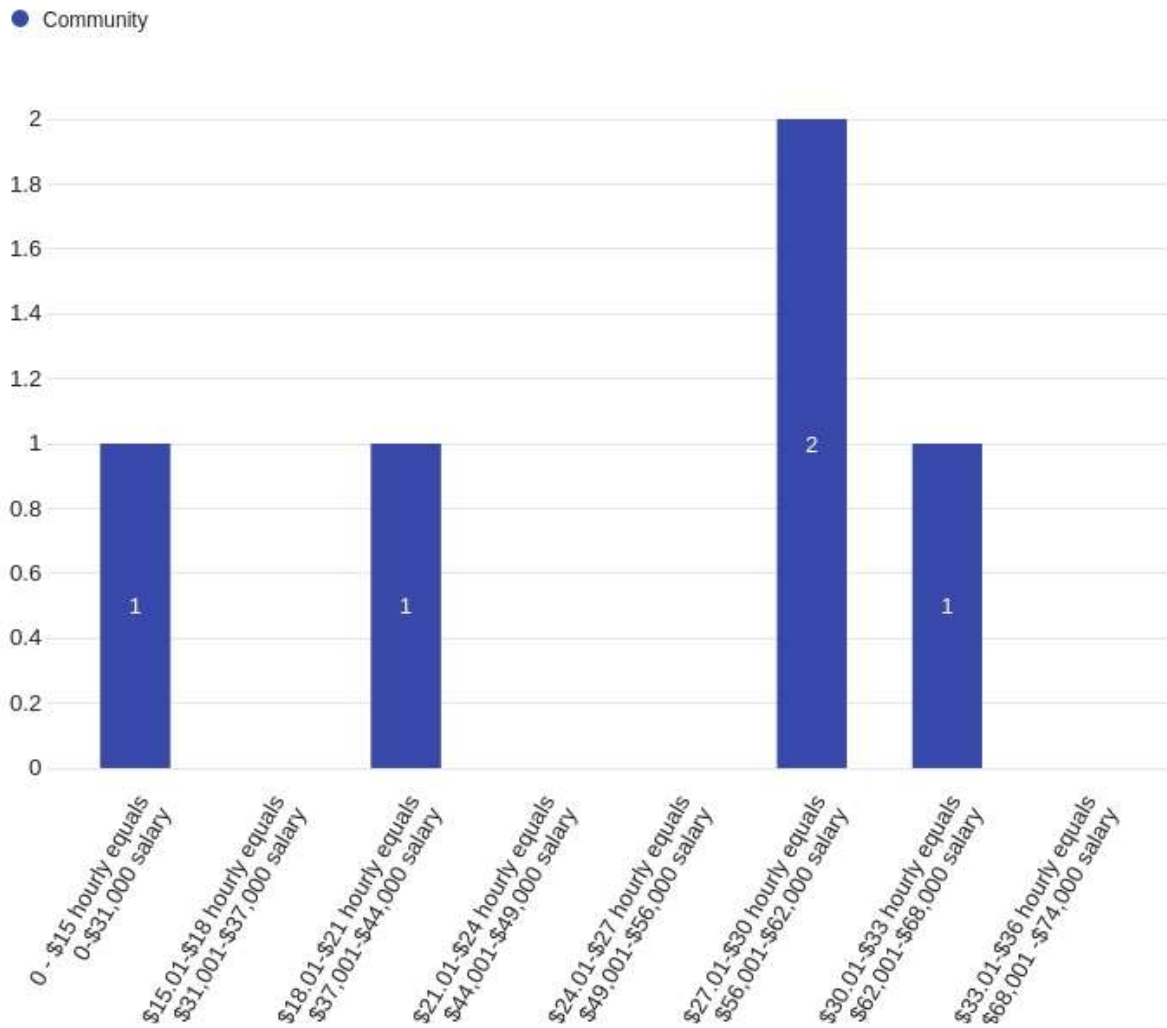

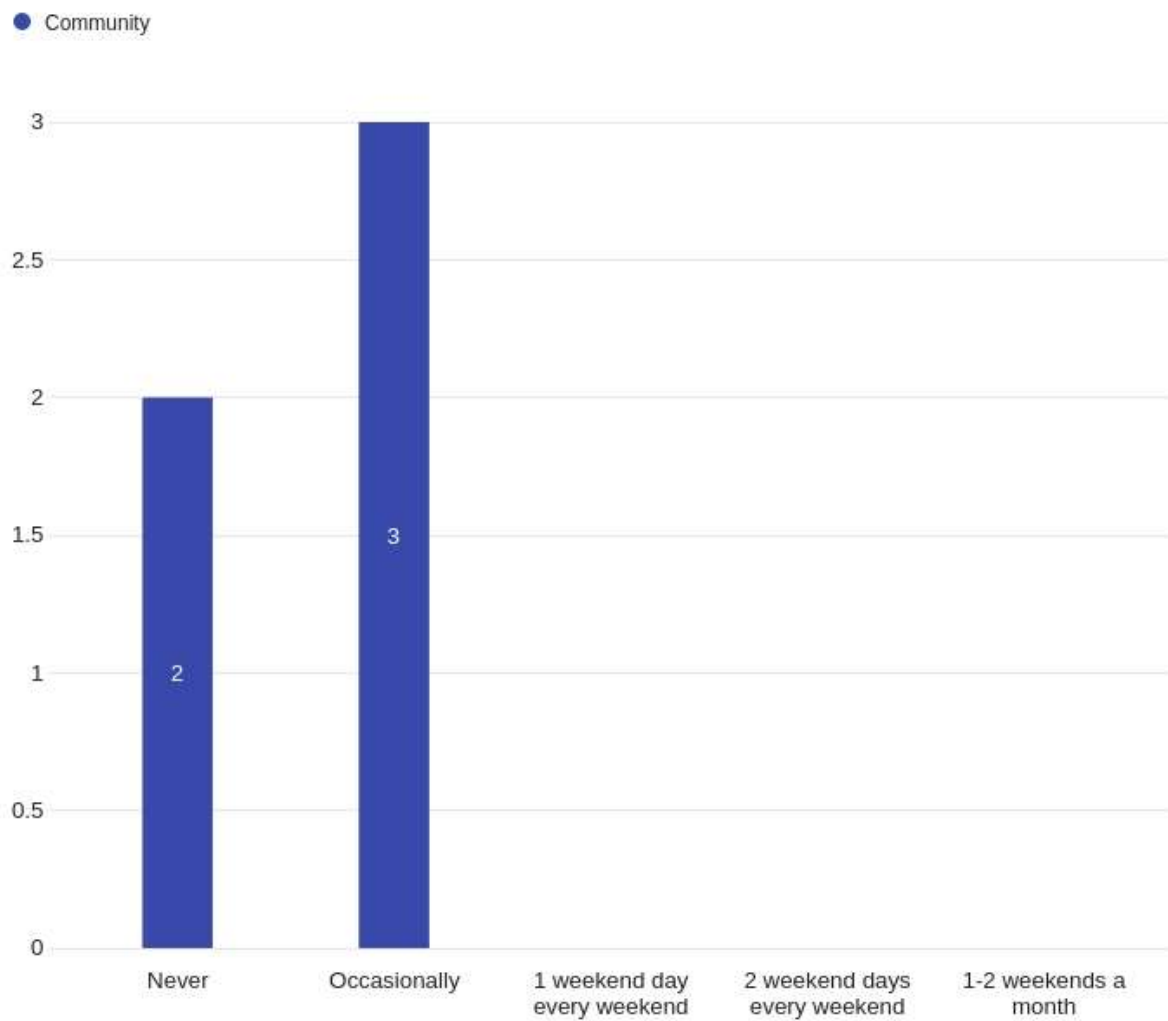

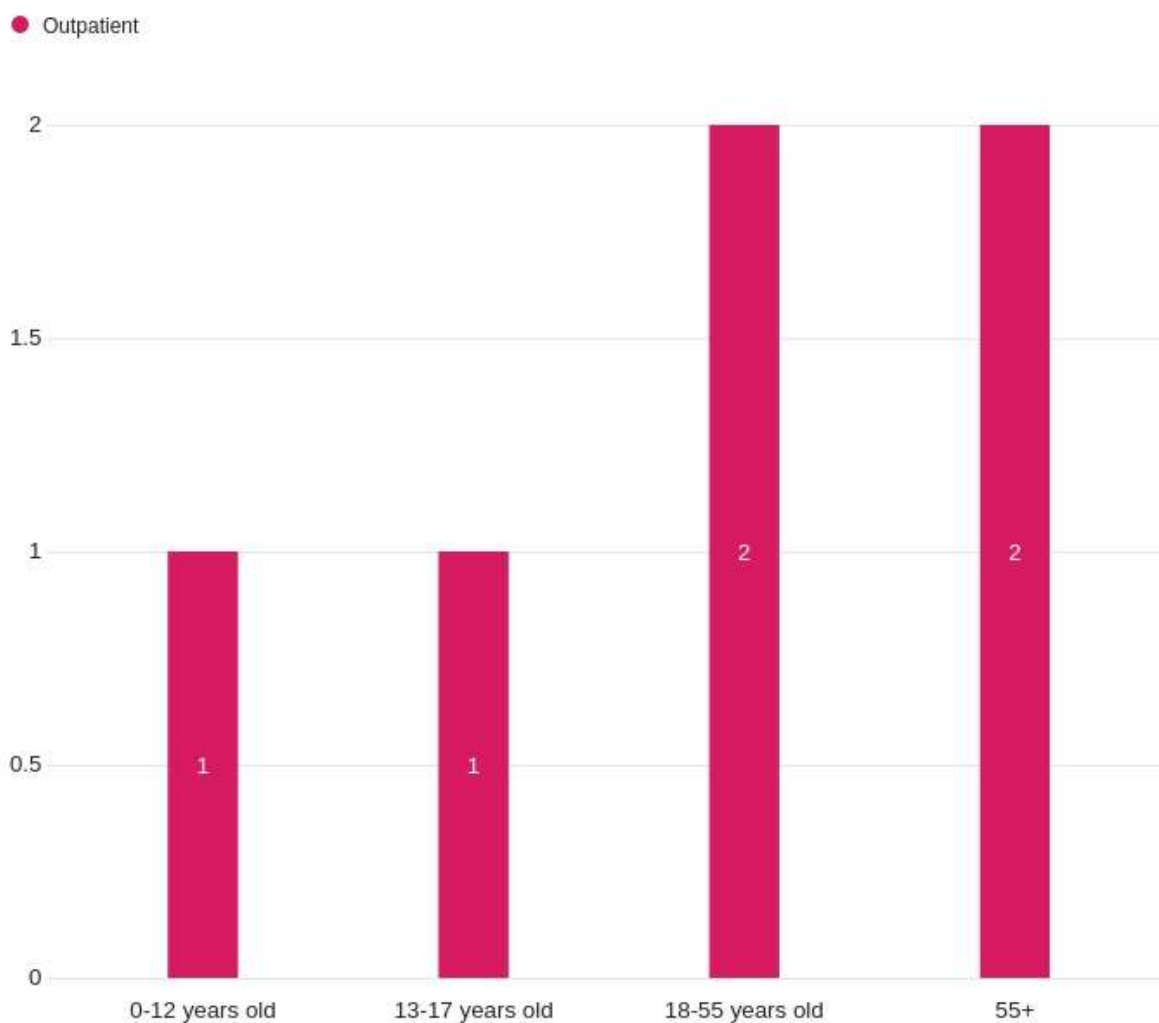

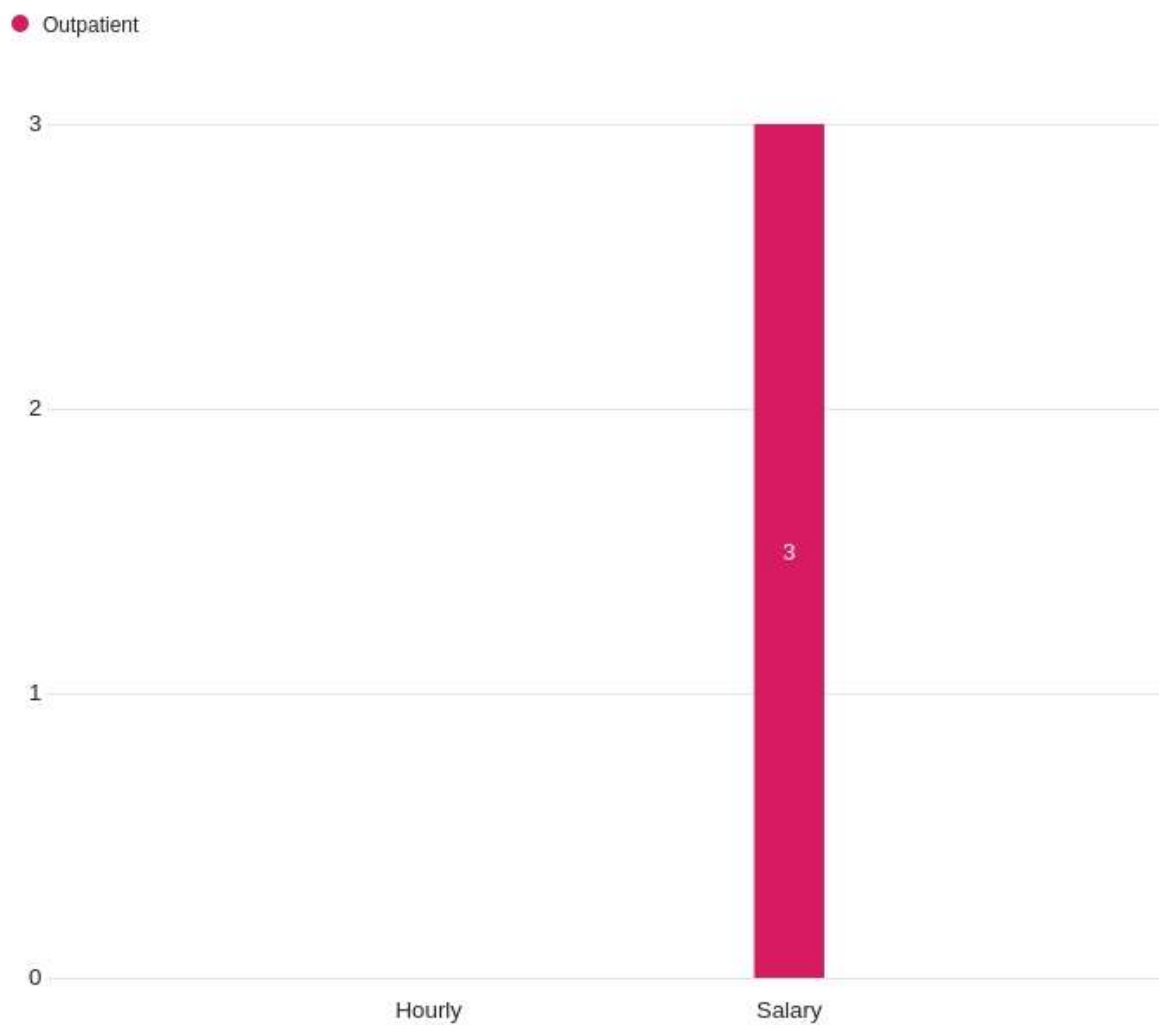

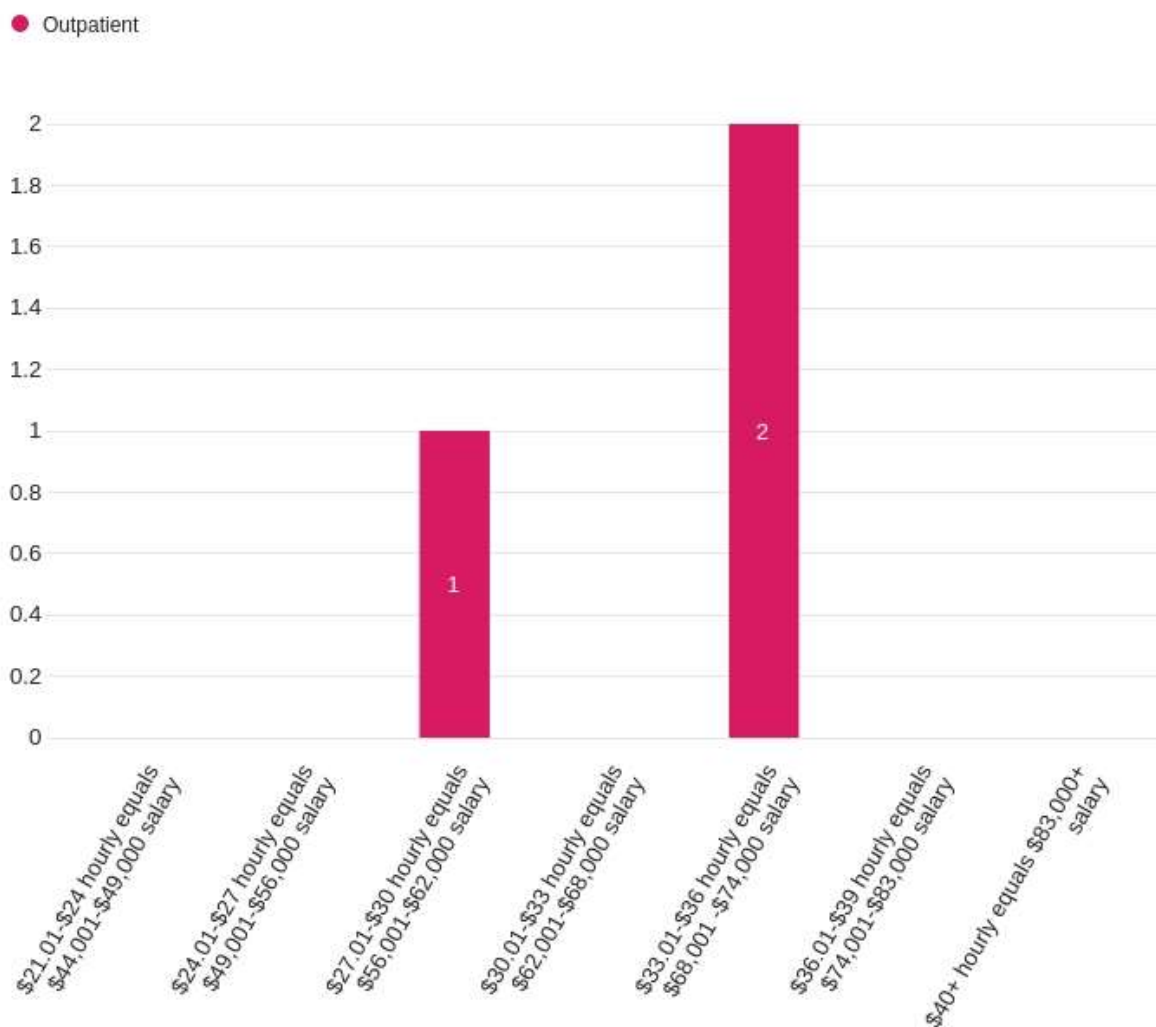

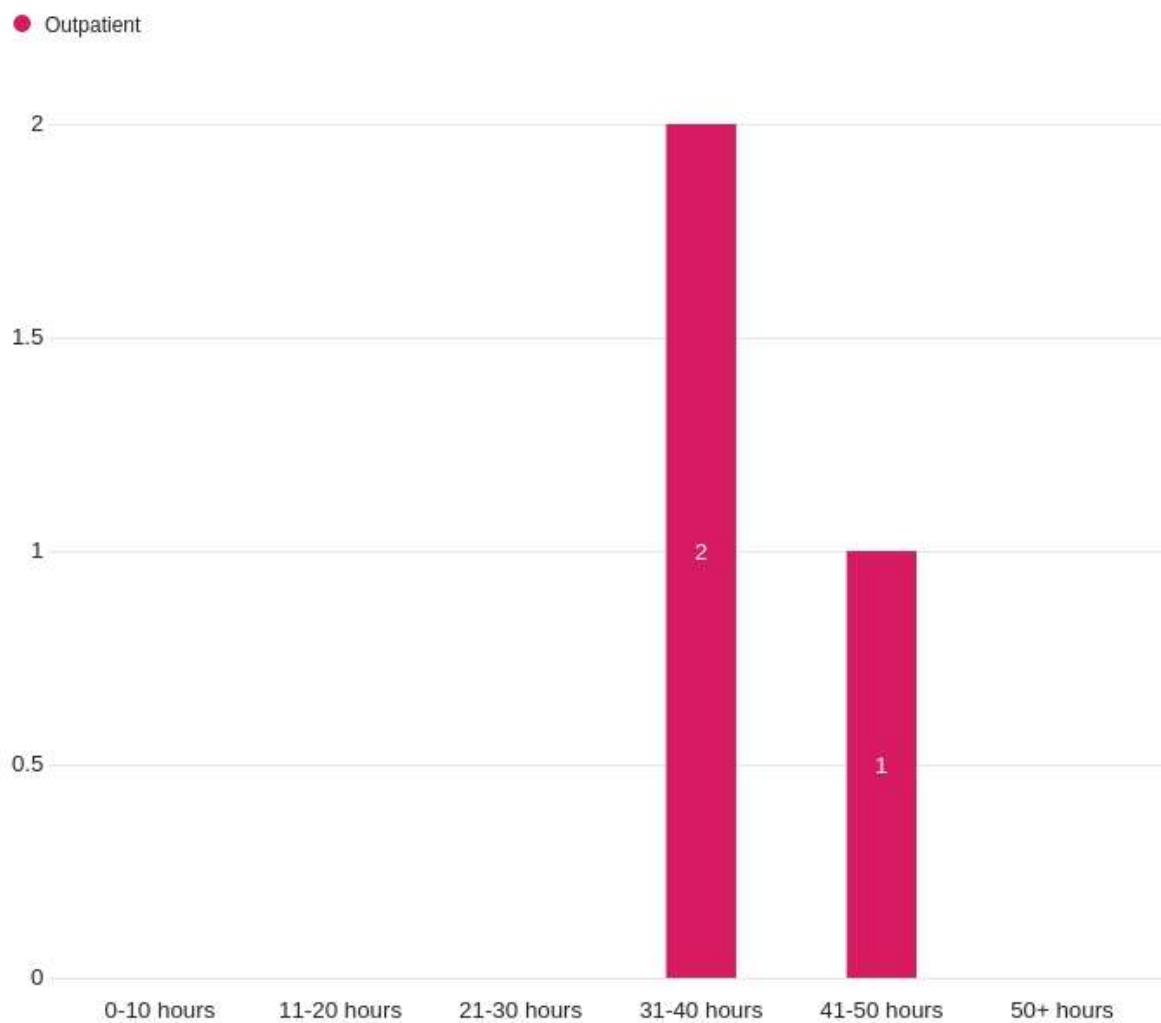

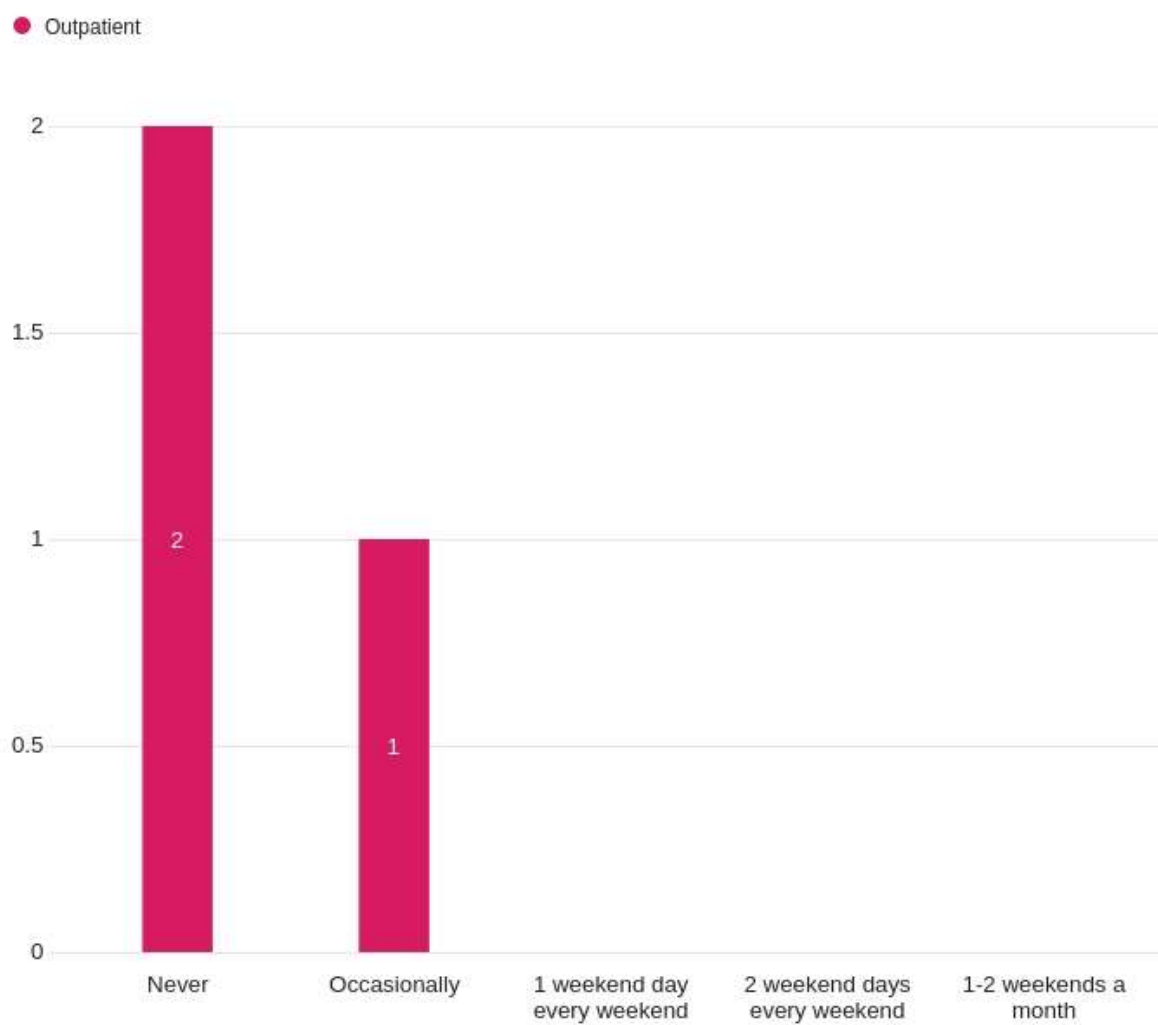

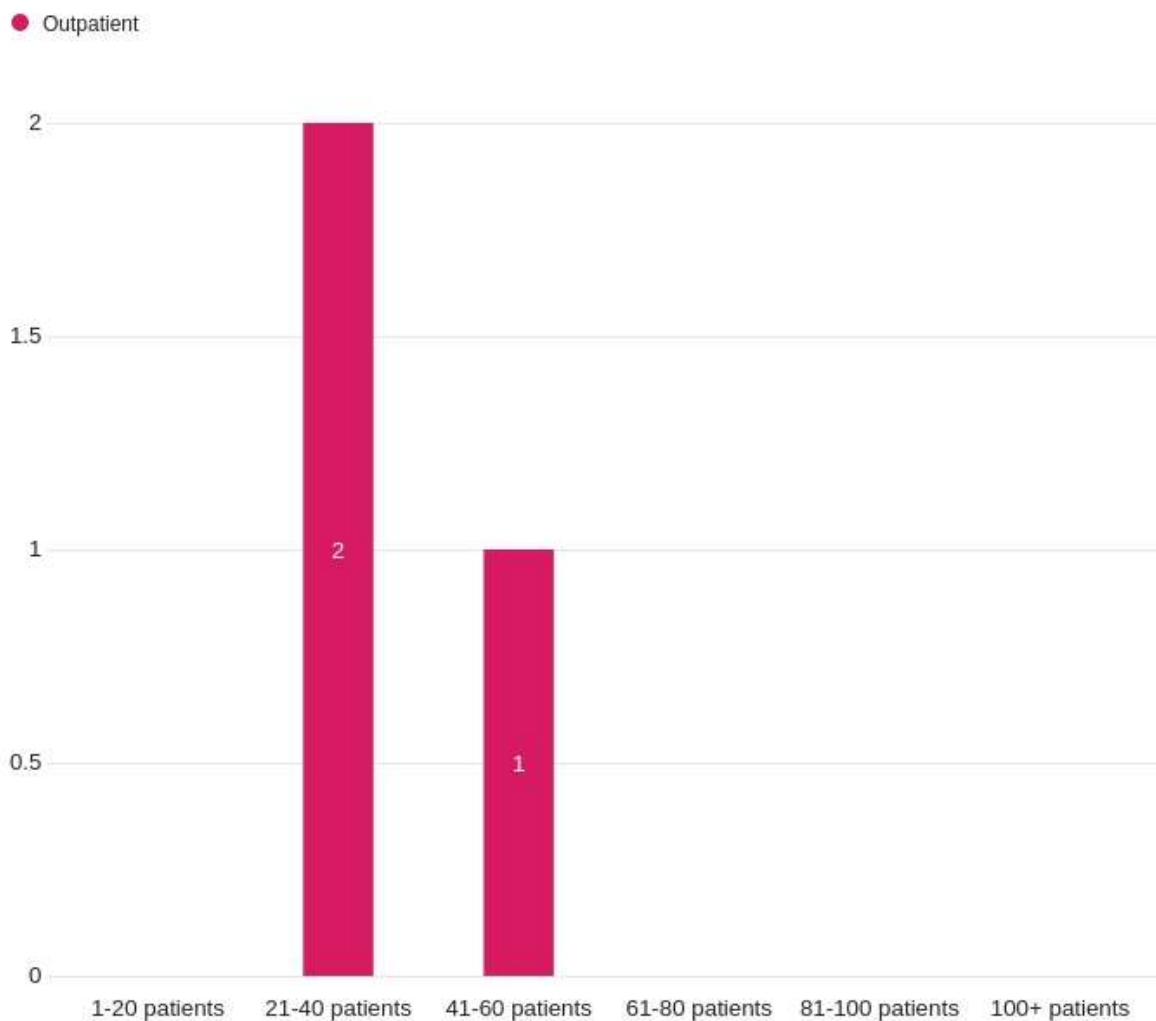

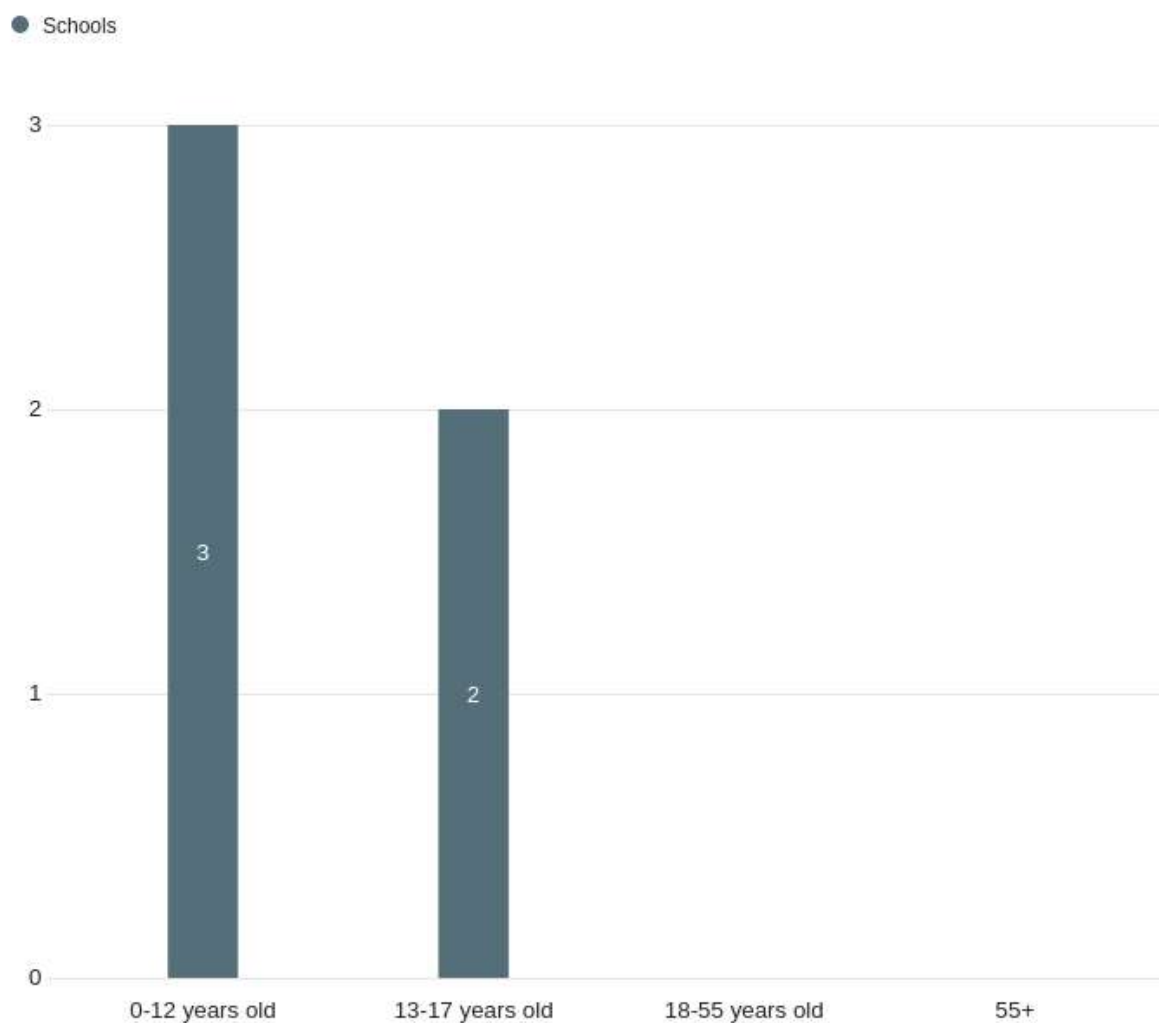

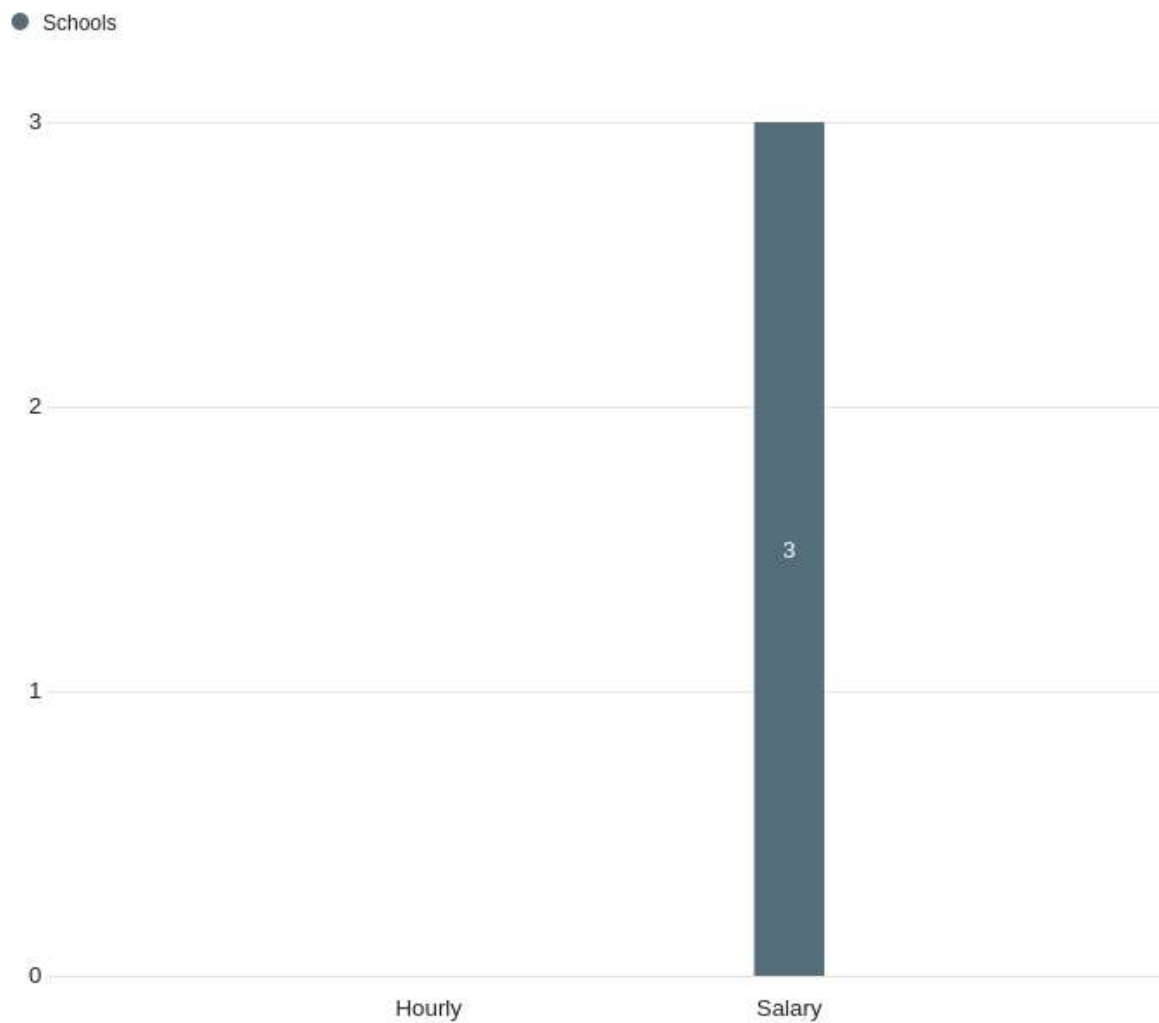

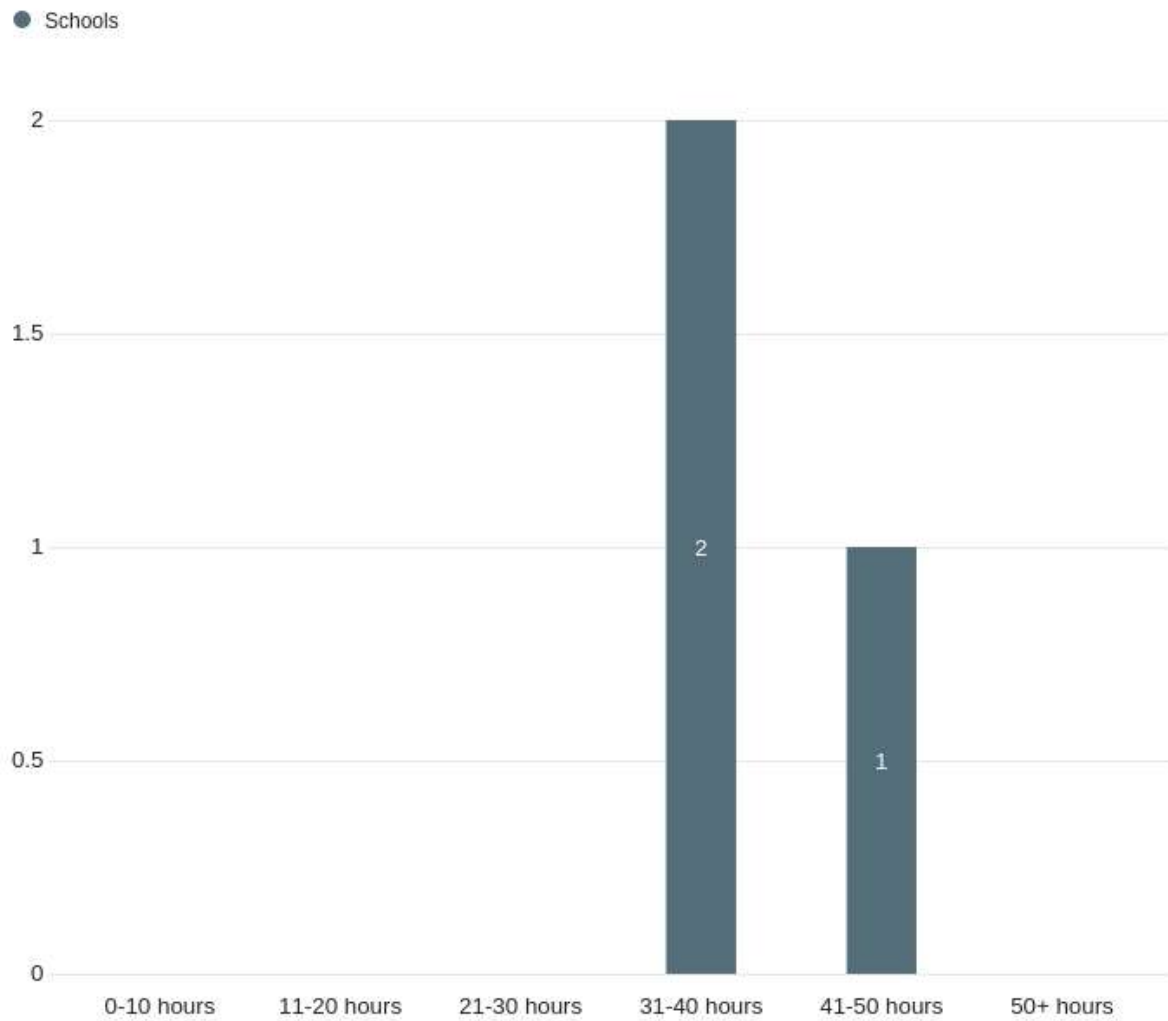

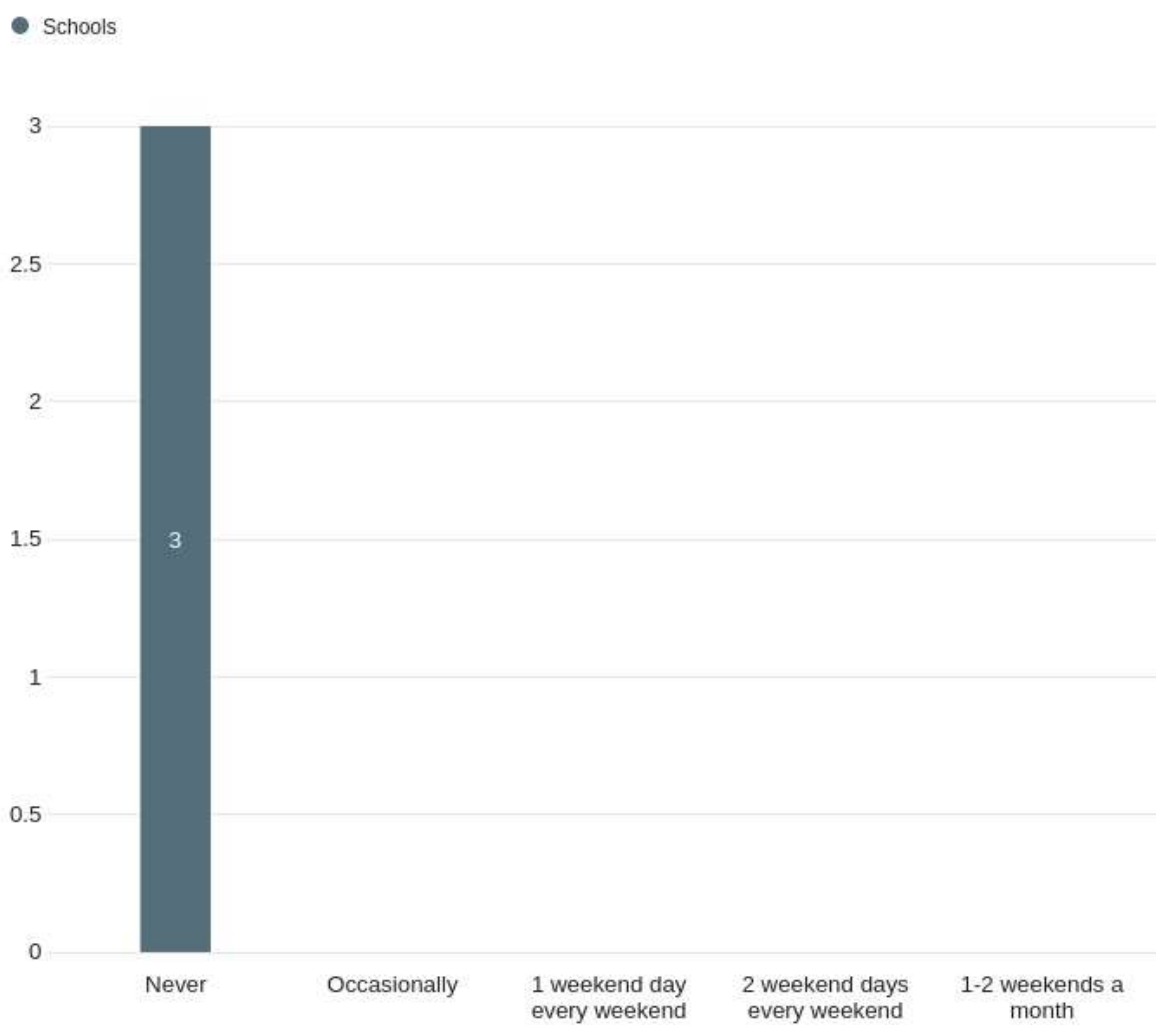

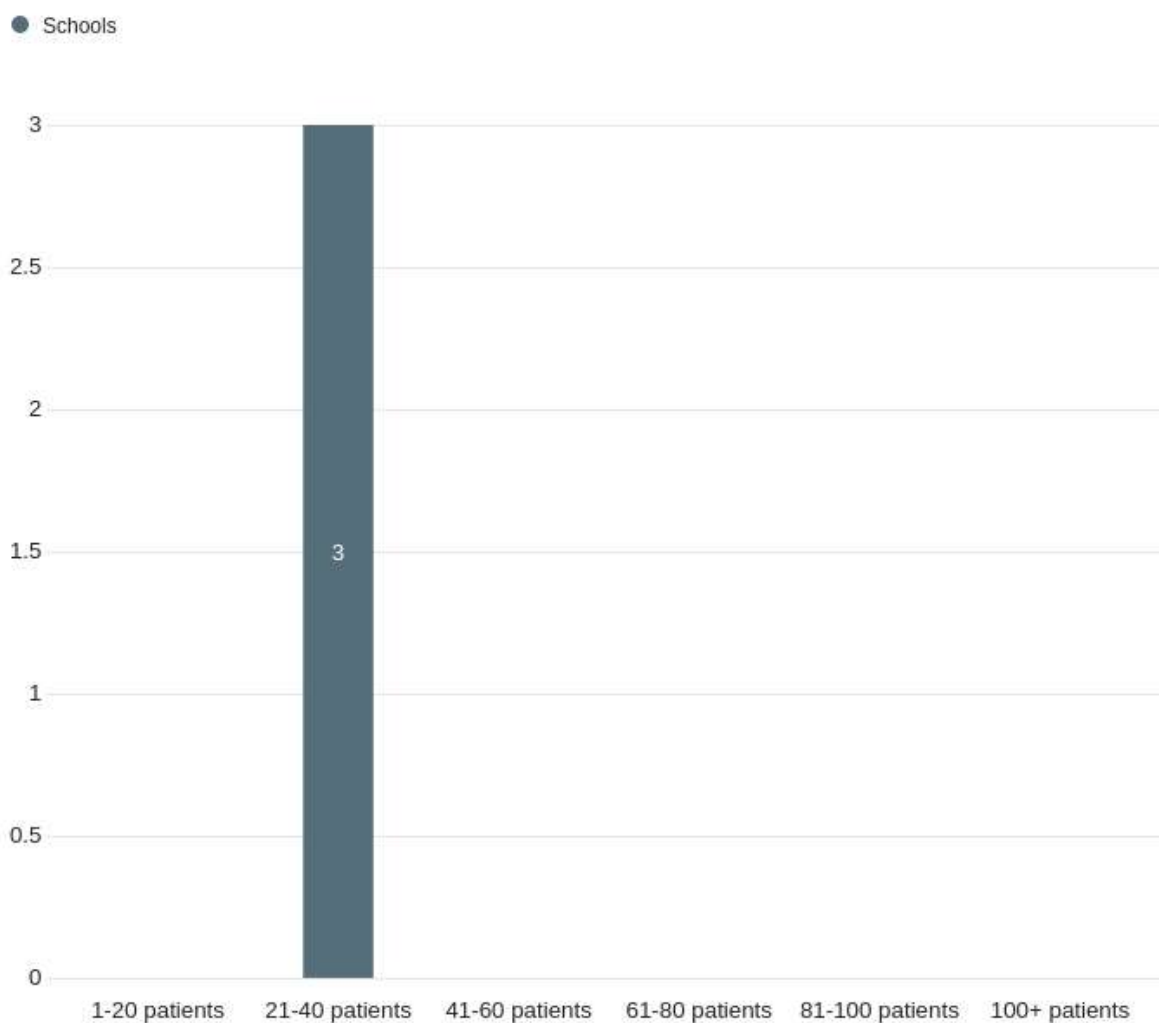

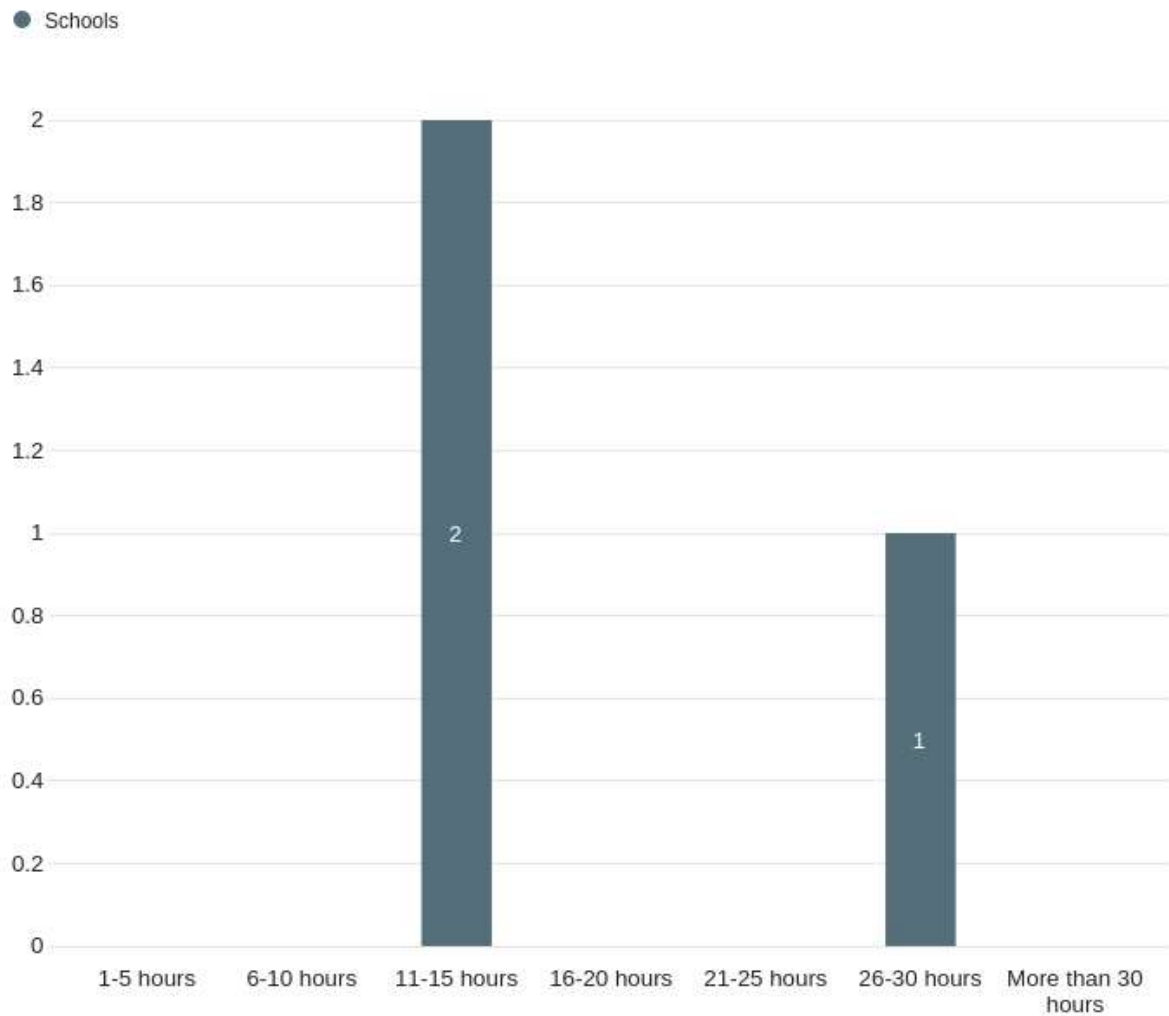

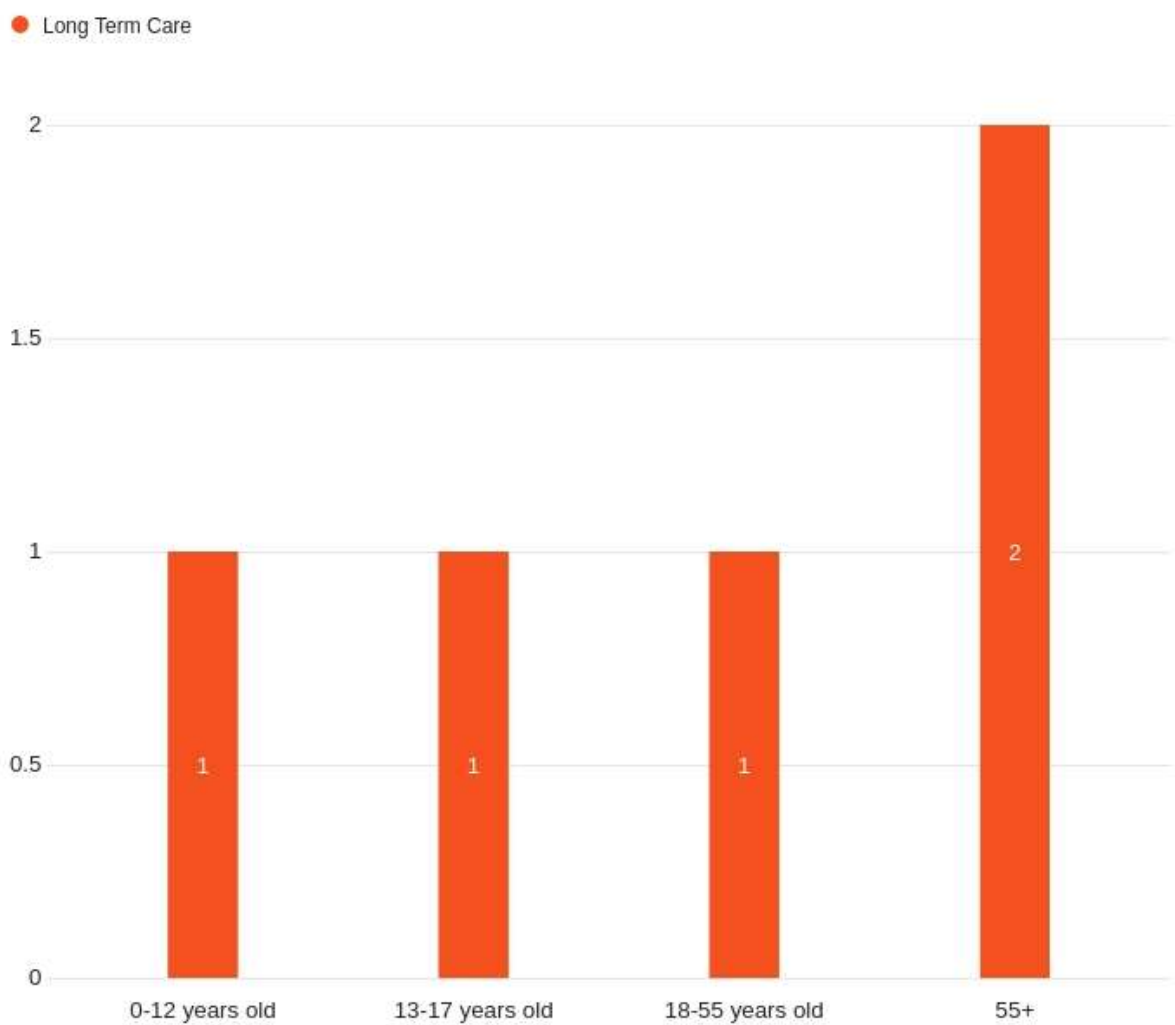

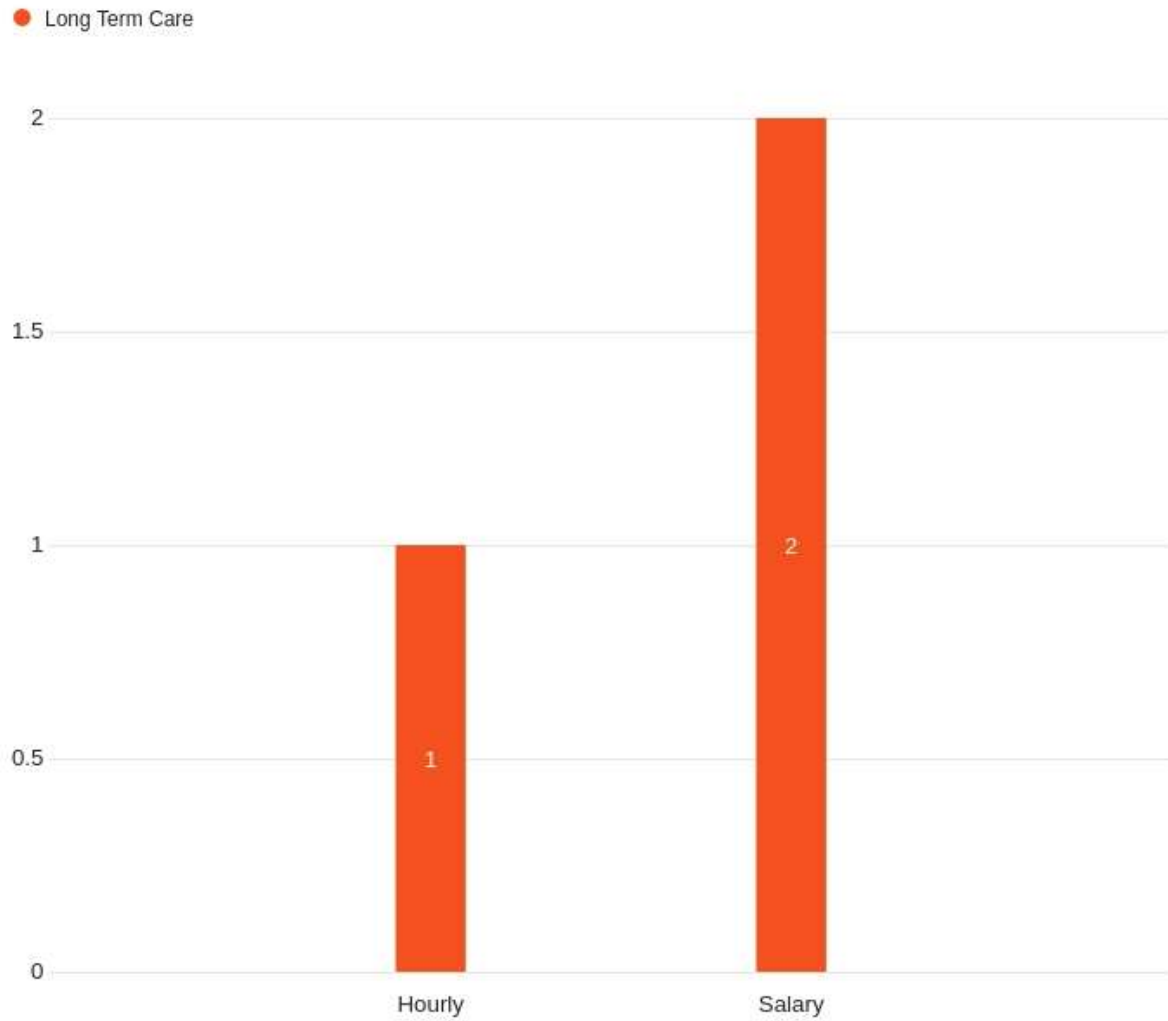

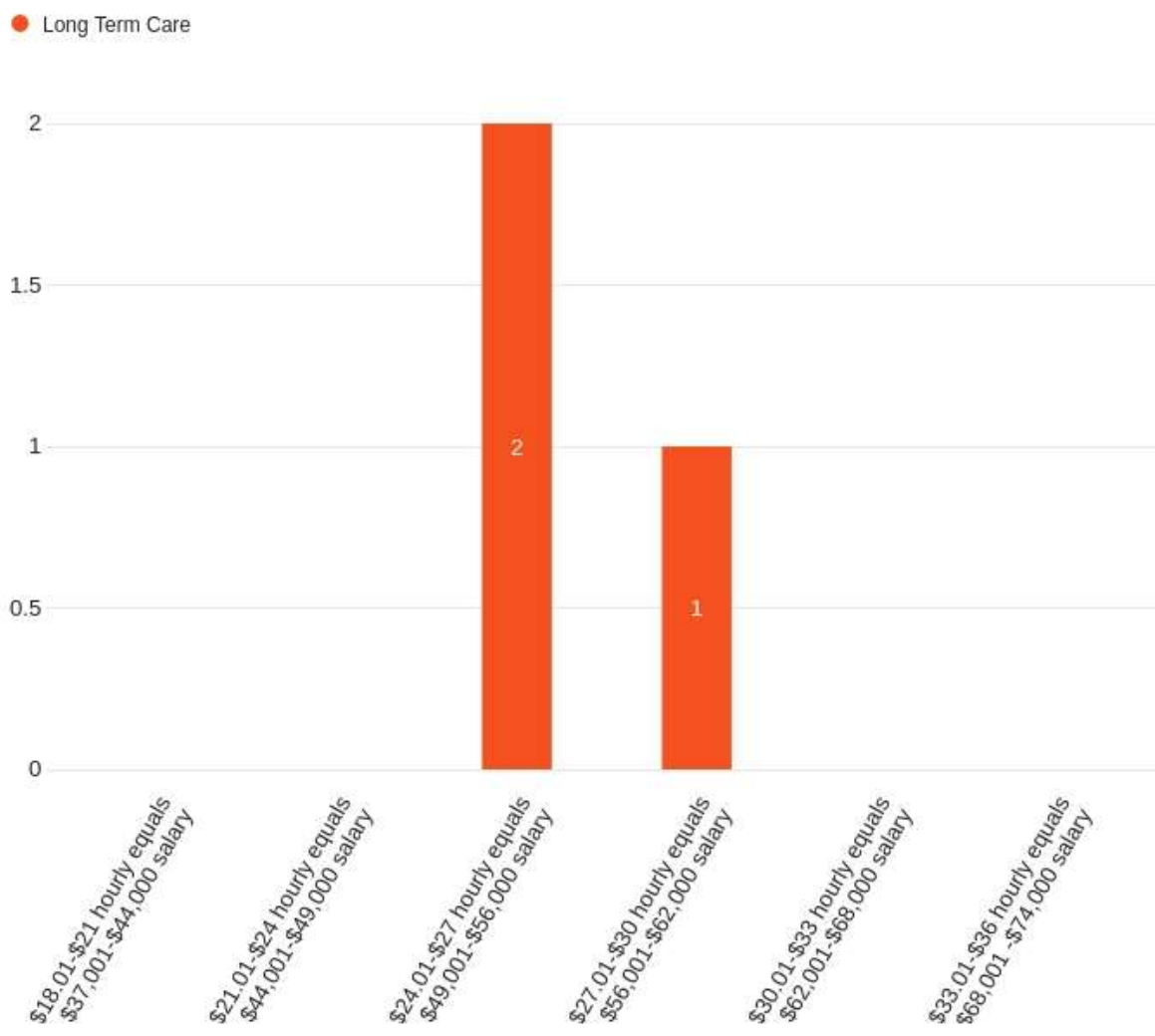

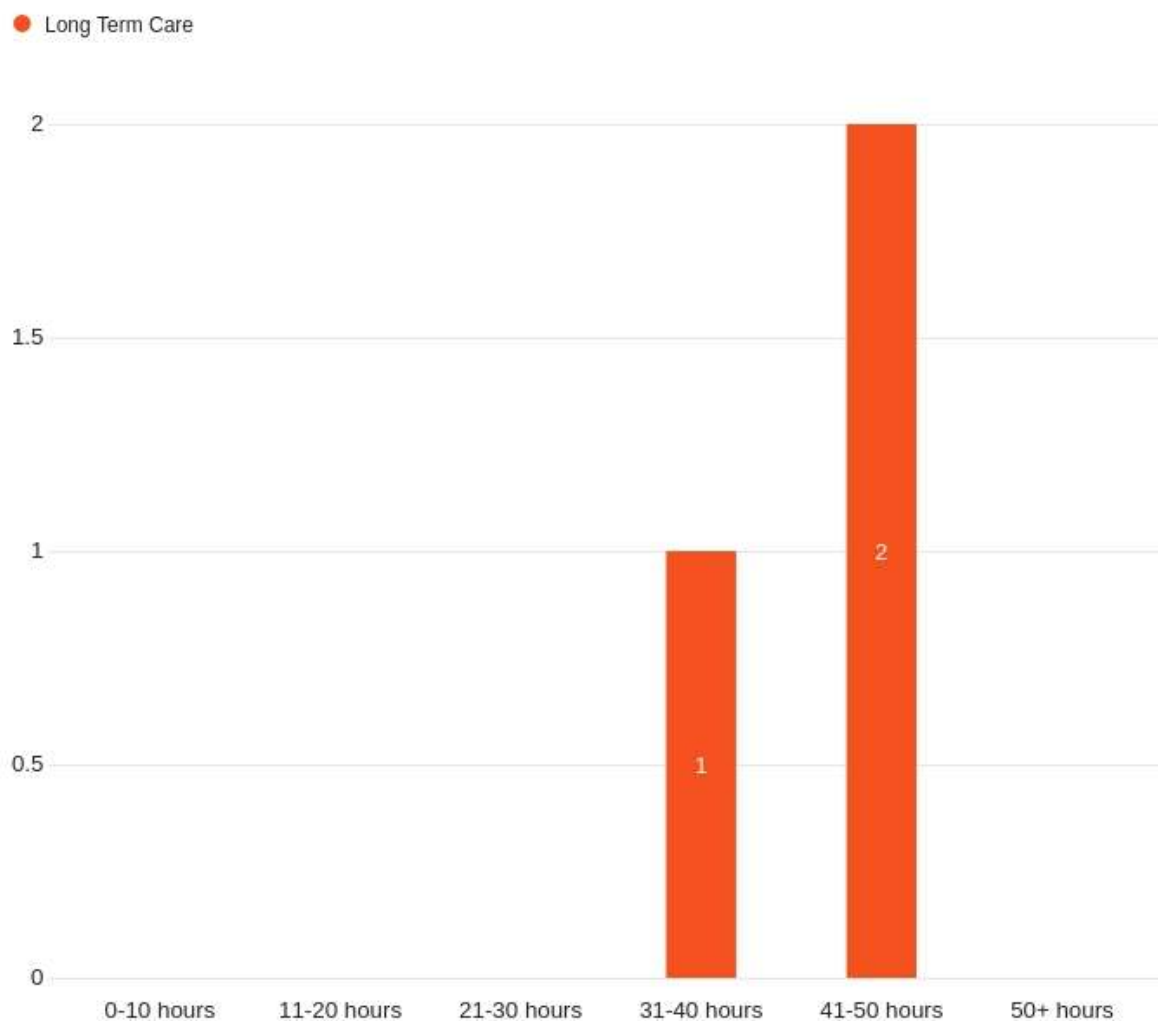

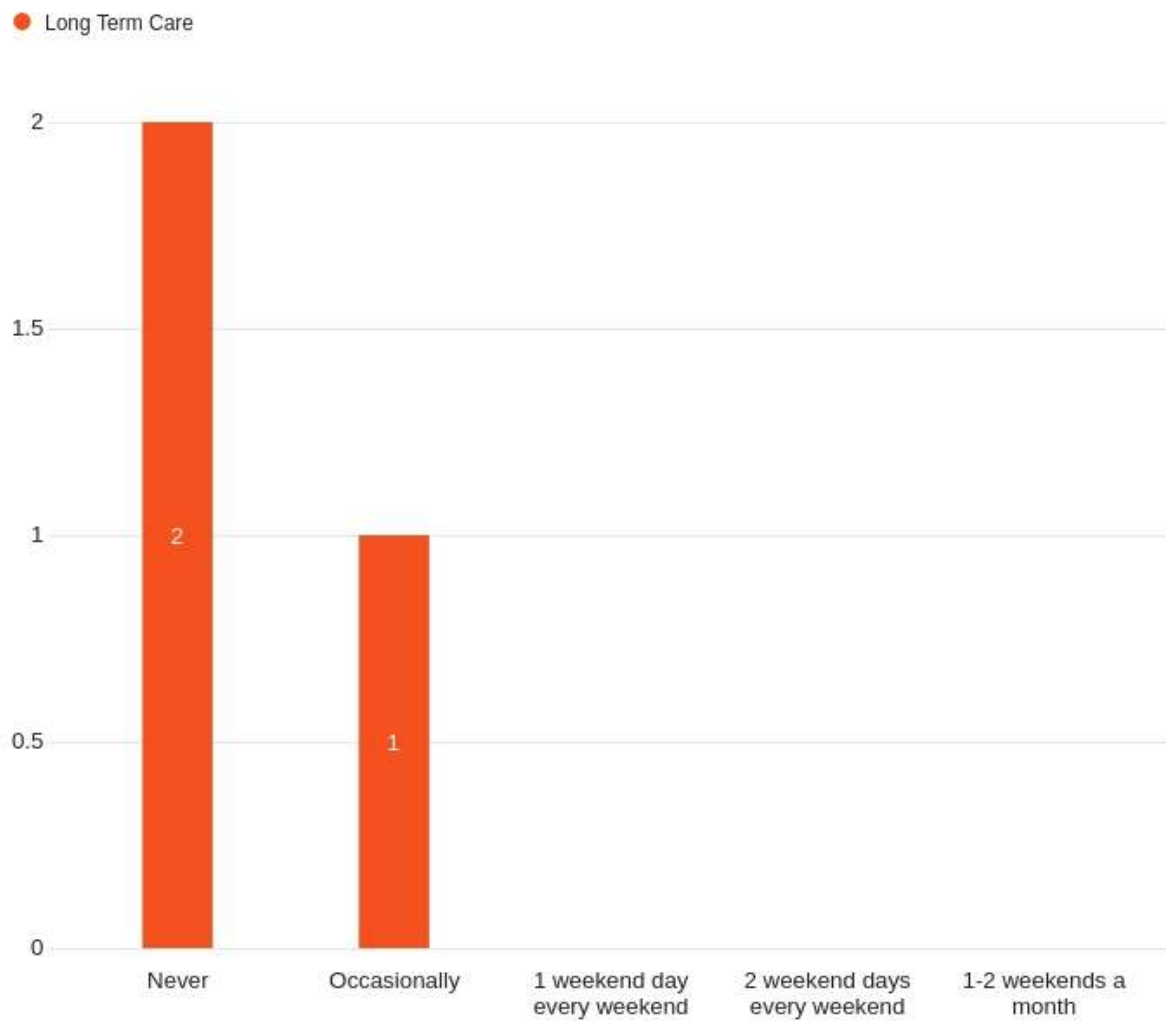

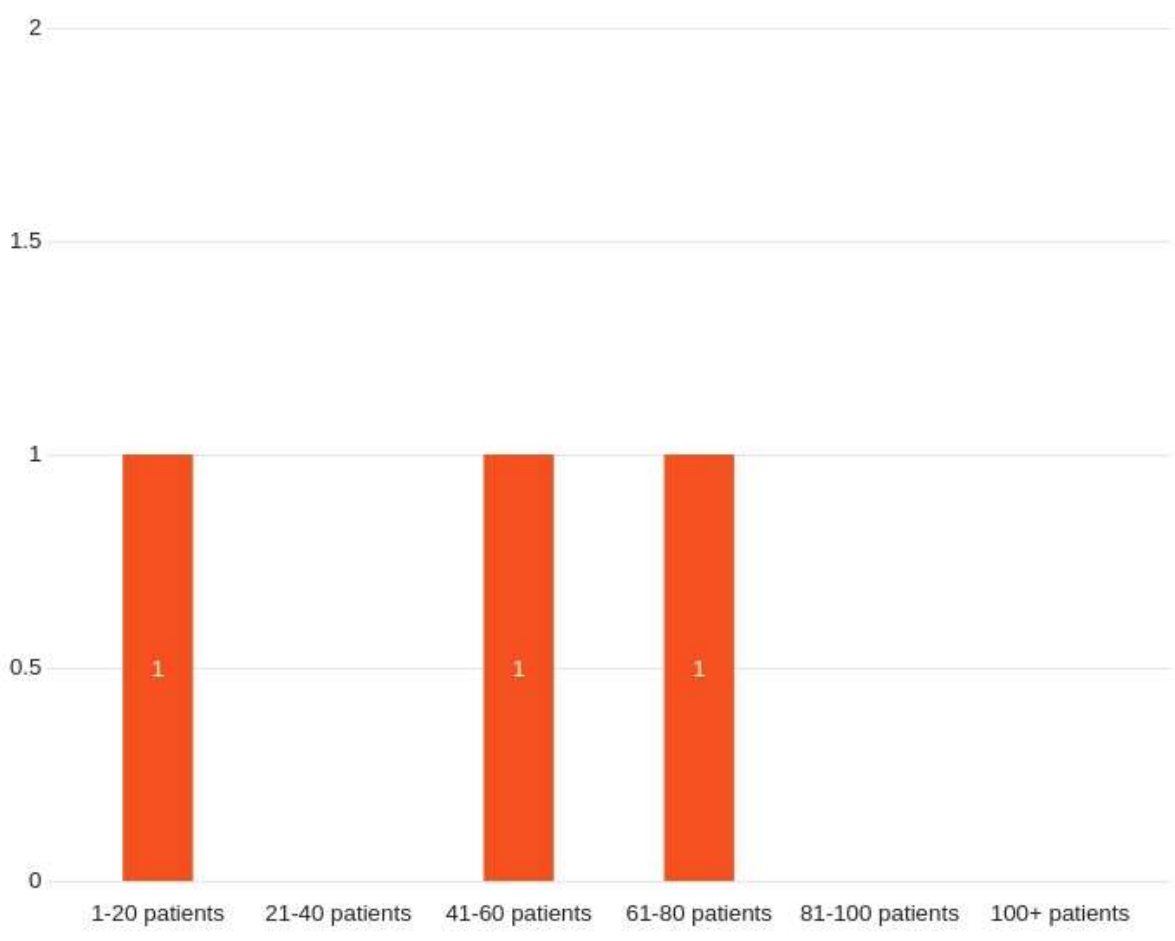

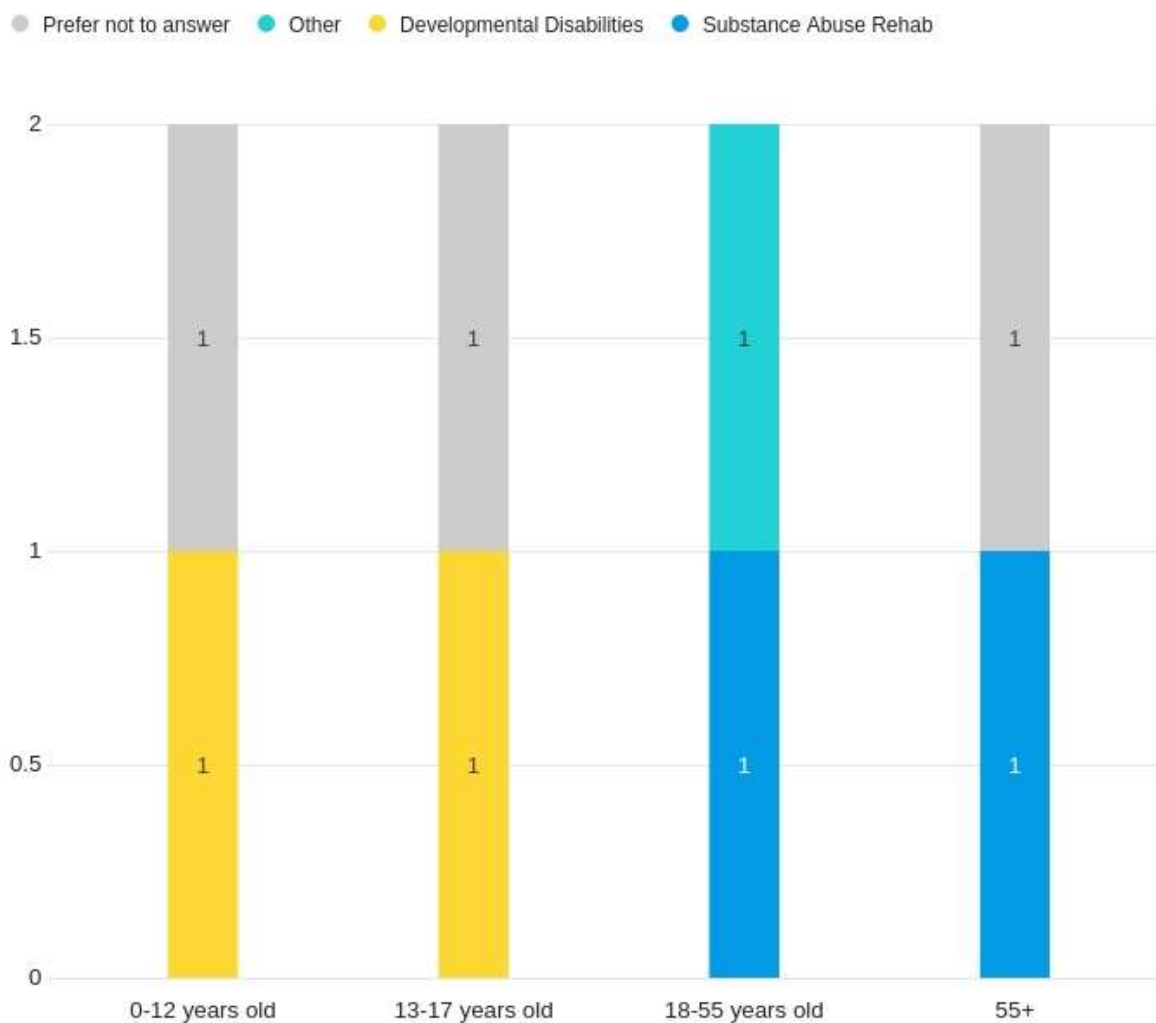

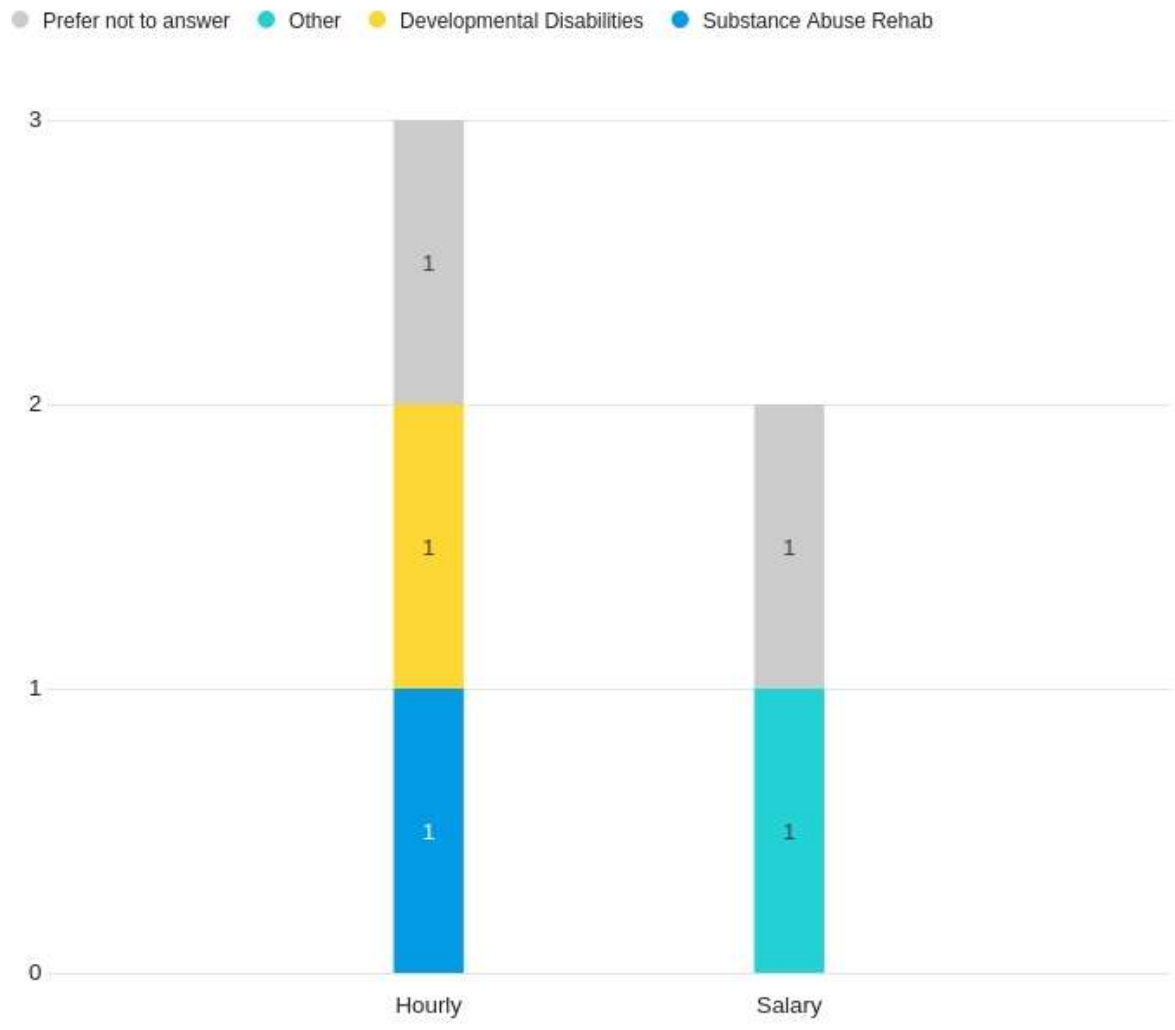

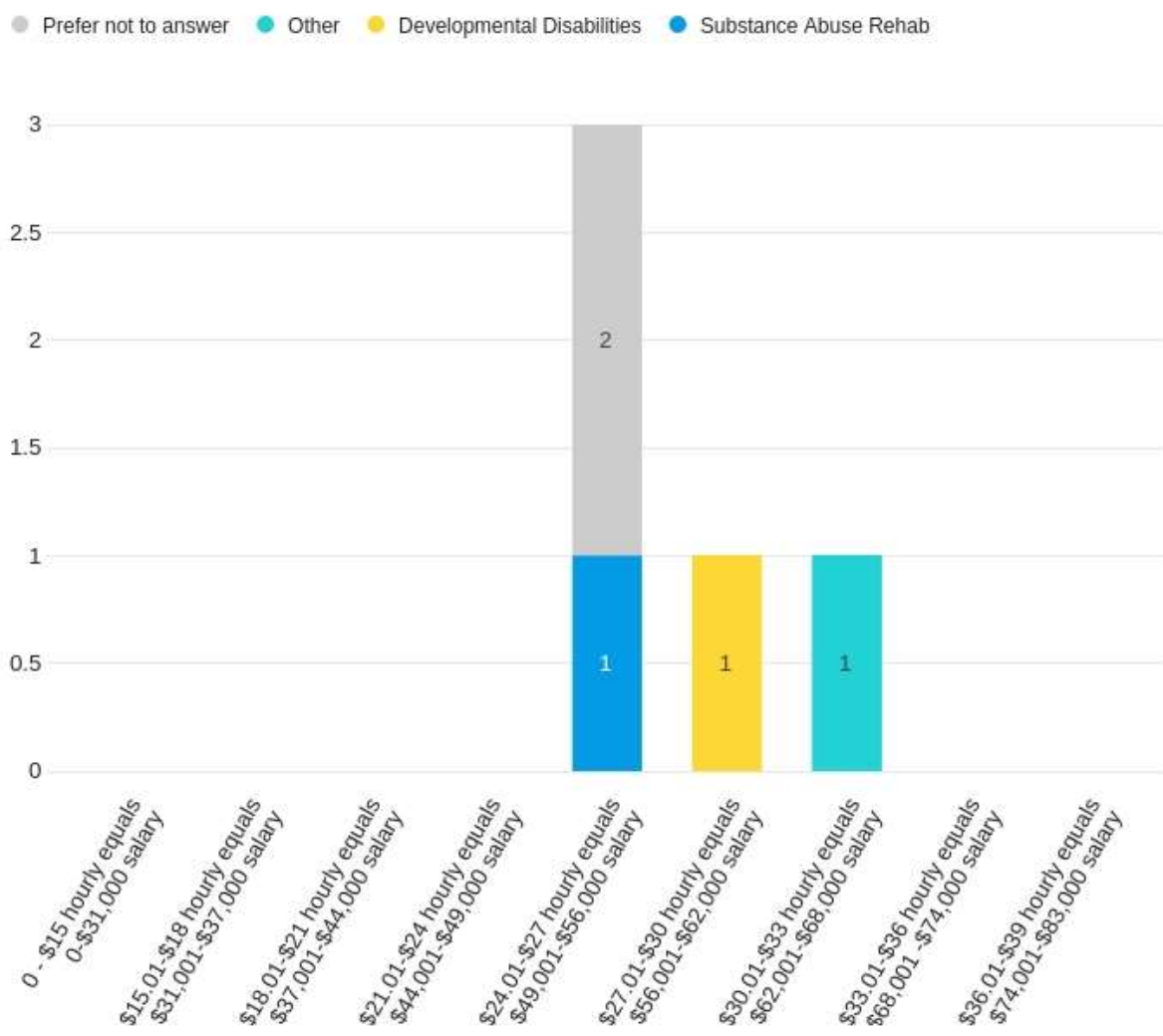

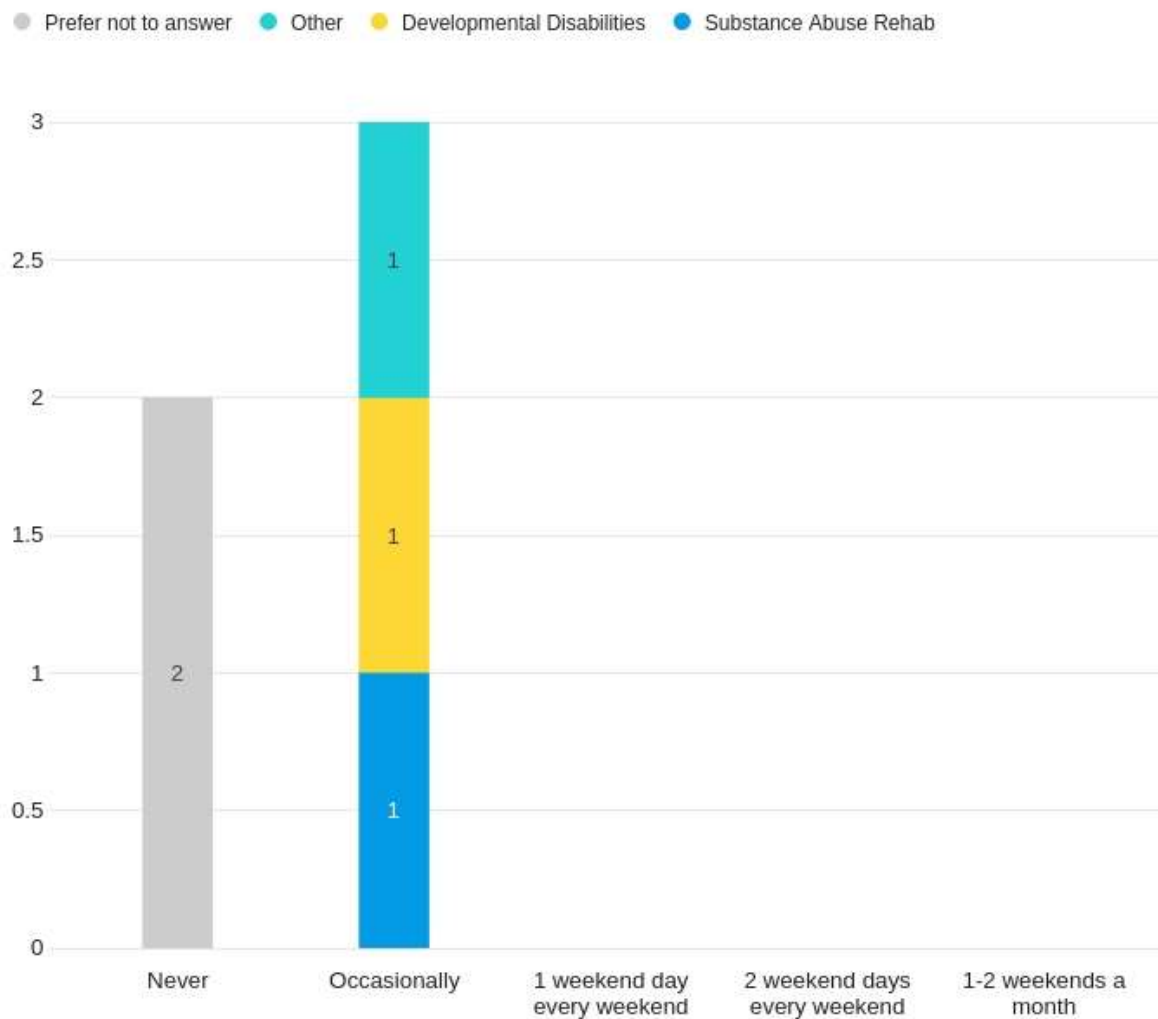

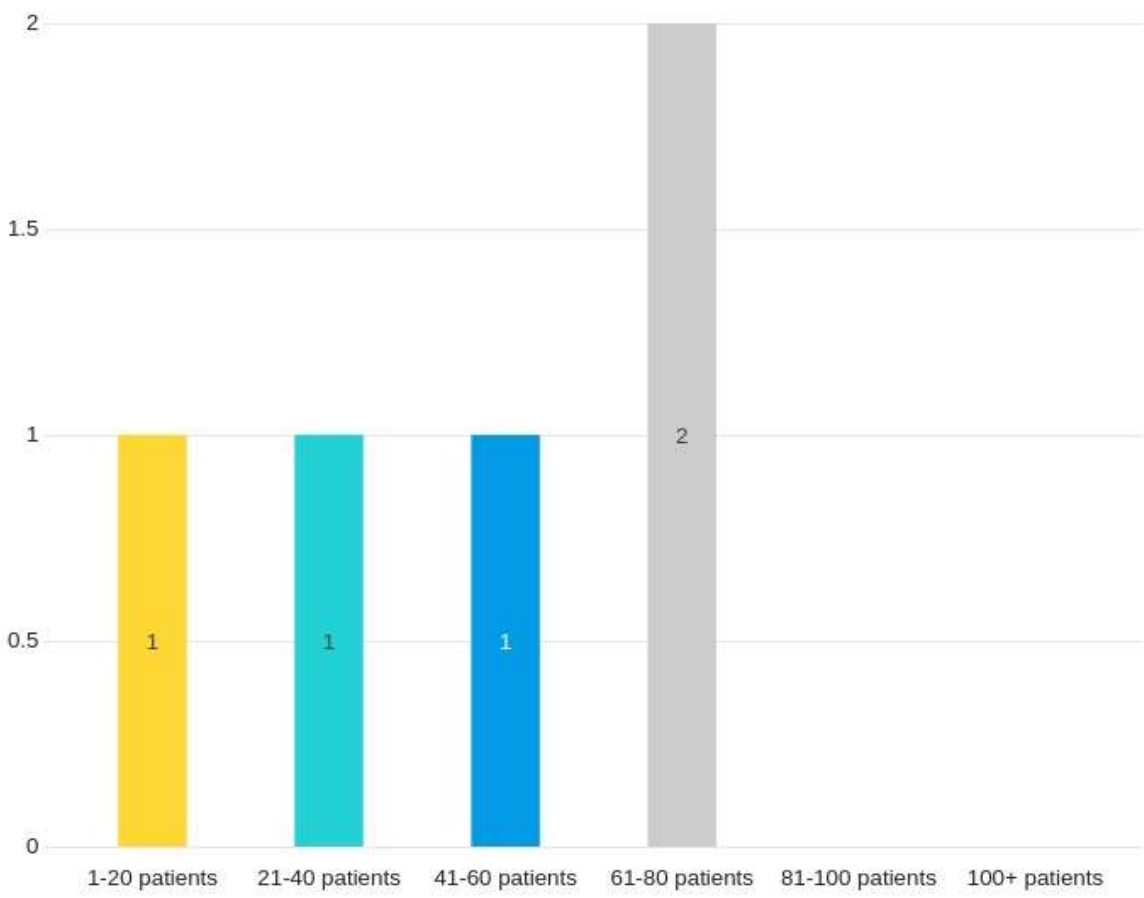
